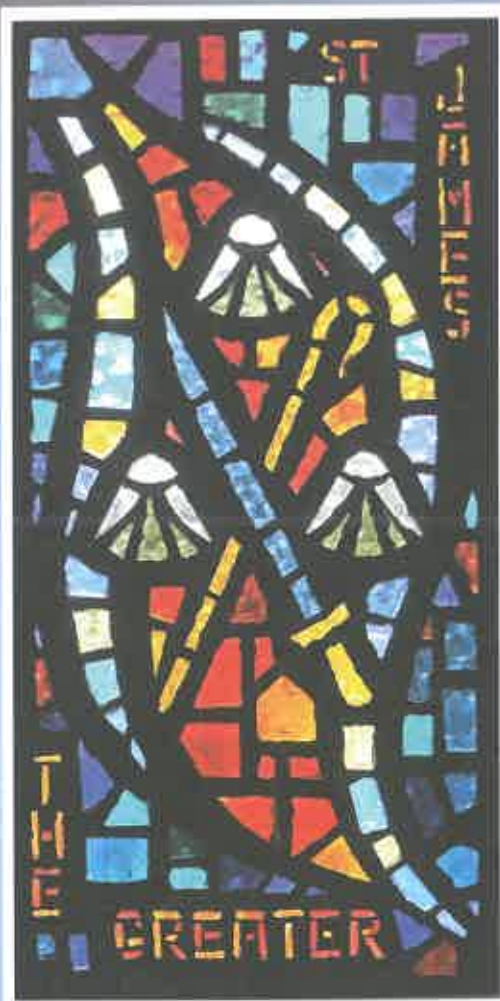
INFANT BAPTISMS – The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd Sunday of each month at the noon Mass and on the 4th Sunday of each month at 1:30 p.m. (outside of Mass). Parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Program, preferably 2 months prior to the birth of the child. The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Seniors' Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

NEW PARISHIONERS – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

BEQUESTS – A bequest to your parish is a way to honor your church and faith of your lifetime. A bequest, included in your will, is exempt from estate and inheritance taxes, and reduces the amount of the estate to be taxed. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

VIRTUS®—Child Protection—Update

Child Protection Policy—Protecting God's Children:

New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY, when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. St. James' next workshop is **Wednesday, February 21, 2018 at 6 pm.** See our web page for info, pre-registration and additional workshops at other locations.

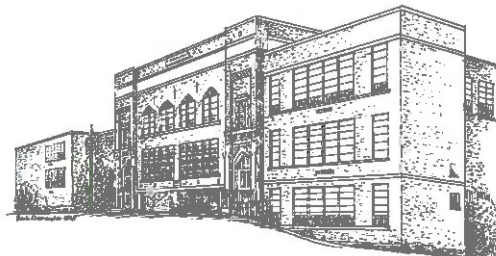

The Week Ahead - Catholic Schools Week is an exciting time for our students and staff to celebrate how blessed we are to be a part of the St. James community. Tuesday is Community Day in which Mass will be celebrated at the cathedral with representative families from each parish school. Additionally, The Children's Theatre will present *The Cat in the Hat* for grades K-4 and *Maya Angelou* for grades 5-8. Wednesday is A Day of Thanksgiving. Thursday is School Staff Day when we will celebrate our dedicated staff with a luncheon. Also, on Thursday evening, the 4th grade class will perform their mini musical at 7:00 p.m. Friday is Kids Day, when we celebrate all of our wonderful students with a *Mad Science* program for grades K-4 and exciting games of dodgeball and *Minute to Win It* for grades 5-8!

Archdiocesan Financial Aide - The Archdiocese of Cincinnati is now accepting applications for financial aide for the 2018-2019 school year through the Catholic

Education Foundation. In order to apply, families must complete the FACTS Grant and Aid Application. (FACTS is the tuition collection program used at St. James already.) **Applications must be received by January 31, 2018.** Eligible families can be awarded up to \$1,000 per student to attend St. James next year. Funds will be distributed based on the assessed financial need of families and will be without distinguishing between families based on religion or parishioner status. For Parish Assistance: When you have your 2017 Tax Returns, upload them to FACTS so you will also be eligible for Parish Assistance. **The Deadline for St. James Parish is April 15, 2018.**

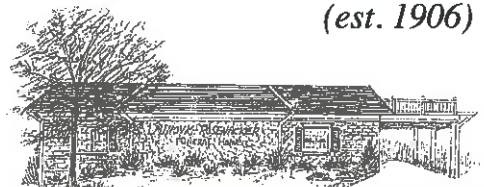
