Parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Program, preferably 2 months prior to the birth of the child. The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Seniors' Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

**NEW PARISHIONERS** – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

**CHANGE OF ADDRESS** – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

**BEQUESTS** – A bequest to your parish is a way to honor your church and faith of your lifetime. A bequest included in your will is exempt from estate and inheritance taxes, and reduces the amount of the estate to be taxed. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

**St. James Church is celebrating its 175th Anniversary in 2018 and we want you to be a part of it!** We invite all parishioners to prepare a Family History Display to be used throughout the anniversary year at events including the **Kick-off Celebration after the 8:00 and 10:00 am Masses on Sunday, November 26th.**

The purpose is to capture pictures and memorabilia that highlights your personal family history with St. James and the community. Some things you may want to include: Family Name; Pictures: Baptism, 1st Holy Communion, May Crowning, Weddings, Family Photos, Social Events, Parish Picnic, Festival, Bingo, Fish Fry, Volunteer Fair along with written short stories - Family History, Church History and White Oak Community. Below is an example of one idea for a family history poster. Feel free to include short stories or anything else you think would help depict your family and its history.

**Additional Details:** **1.** Submit to Parish Office by **November 20, 2017.** **2.** Poster should be on standard poster board (22" x 28") or smaller and have the family contact information on the back of the poster. **3.** Posters will be kept by the Anniversary Committee and returned after the Parish Picnic 2018. **4.** Submit copies of original documents. 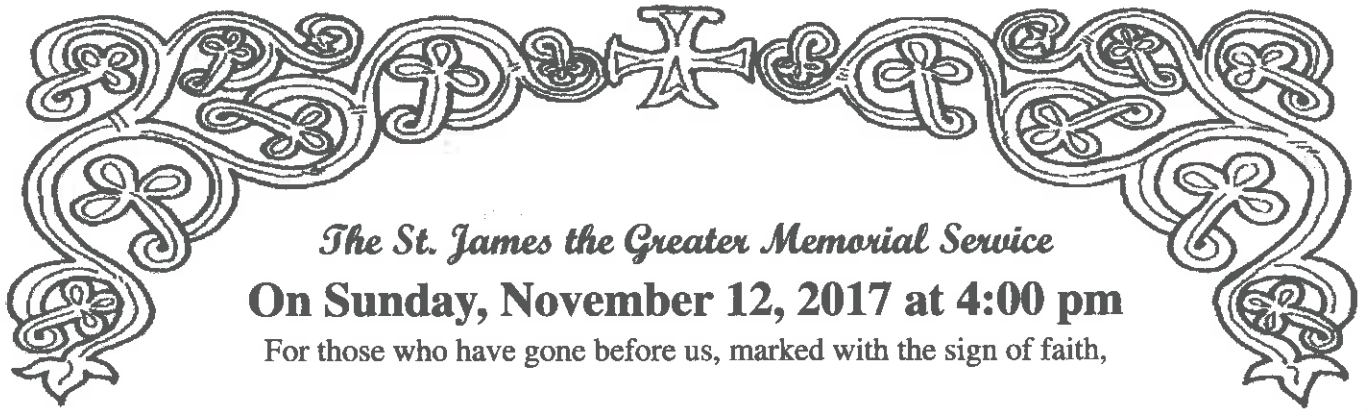
## Book of Remembrance

### VIRTUS®—Child Protection—Update

#### Child Protection Policy—Protecting God's Children:

**New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching.** For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY, when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. **St. James' next workshop is Wednesday, NOVEMBER 15TH at 6 pm.** See our web page for info, pre-registration and additional workshops at other locations.

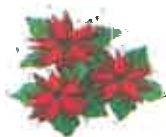

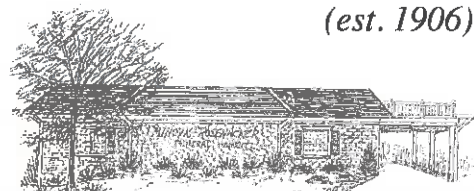
