Pre-History of St. James Parish



17. In April 1840, predominantly German Catholic families in the area began to organize a parish.

18. On August 15, 1840, Father John Martin Henni, S.J. (pastor of Holy Trinity) celebrated the first Mass in a barn belonging to Sylvester Oehler.

- 19. This became known as "St. James Station."
- 20. In 1841, the founders decided to build a log church on two acres of land that was donated by the Oehler and Werth families on Burnt School House Road (now Cheviot Road).
- 21. They were guided by Reverend Joseph Ferneding. Plans were made for a school as well. To build the log church, they needed \$124.62. The average monthly collection was around \$10, so it was difficult to raise the needed funds. They raised \$66.62 ½, which was enough for walls and a roof.

New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement. Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. Archdiocesan Financial Aide - The Archdiocese of Cincinnati is now accepting applications for financial aide for the 2018-2019 school year through the Catholic

Education Foundation. In order to apply, families must complete the FACTS Grant and Aid Application. (FACTS is the tuition collection program used at St. James already.) Applications must be received by January 31, 2018. Eligible families can be awarded up to \$1,000 per student to attend St. James next year. Funds will be distributed based on the assessed financial need of families and will be without distinguishing between families based on religion or parishioner status. 


