INFANT BAPTISMS – The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd Sunday of each month at the noon Mass and on the 4th Sunday of each month at 1:30 p.m. (outside of Mass). Parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Program, preferably 2 months prior to the birth of the child. The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Seniors' Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

NEW PARISHIONERS – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

BEQUESTS – A bequest to your parish is a way to honor your church and faith of your lifetime. A bequest, included in your will, is exempt from estate and inheritance taxes, and reduces the amount of the estate to be taxed. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

Reverend Henry (Harry) Meyer, Pastor 1920-1931



REV. HENRY MEYER

54 The parish had bought ten acres on Hubble Road for \$20,000 and spent another \$25,000 building the house. Even with the Depression, half of that \$45,000 was paid off by 1931 when Father Meyer left Saint James.

55 One of the other significant achievements of Father Meyer was that in 1926, the parish discontinued the use of “pew rents” as a means of income. Instead, they began a regular collection at each Sunday Mass using envelopes.

Fasting and Abstinence

Good Friday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat and meat products. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding from age 14 onwards.

Learn Together

Image of The Divine Mercy and Its Promises



Jesus wants every soul to know about this Image, which is to remind us “to trust in Him and be merciful to others” (*Diary*, 342). Our Lord attached special promises to venerating the Image of The Divine Mercy (by showing deep religious respect toward it because of the person it represents), promises such as eternal salvation, the grace of a happy death, and of all other possible graces which people will ask of Him with trust (*Diary*, 48). The Image speaks to the heart on a level deeper than mere words. As [St.] Pope John Paul II once said, “Anyone can look at this Image of the Merciful Jesus and hear in the depths of his own soul what [St.] Faustina heard: ‘Fear nothing; I am always with you’ (*Diary*, 586). And if this person responds with a sincere heart, ‘Jesus, I trust in You,’ he will find comfort in all his anxieties and fears.” Attend Holy Mass on Divine Mercy Sunday in a state of grace and receive Holy Communion with great trust in His Mercy and obtain “complete forgiveness of sins and punishment” (*Diary*, 699). VIRTUS®—Child Protection—Update

Child Protection Policy—Protecting God’s Children:

New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. 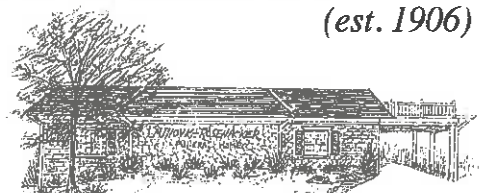
