Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

53. The people who visited the new rectory were amazed, never realizing that such an improvement was possible in White Oak. The rectory was electrically equipped with stove, refrigerator, washer and sweeper,

Fasting and Abstinence

Good Friday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat and meat products. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding from age 14 onwards.

Please join us for an informative evening in the Church Hall on **Tuesday, March 6th at 7 PM,** as Joe Olding presents to us his experience of being a pilgrim walking the Camino de Santiago, the Way of St. James.

DAY PILGRIMAGE TO THE CATHEDRAL BASILICA OF THE ASSUMPTION, AND TO THE CATHEDRAL OF ST. PETER IN CHAINS **Monday March 12, 2018 – 8:30 AM until Approx. 4 PM**

The Group will meet and attend the 8:30 am Mass at St. James. Following Mass we will board the bus for the trip into Covington, Ky to visit the Basilica of the Assumption, the Cathedral of the Diocese of Covington. Our bus will be provided by Queen City Transportation, and with only one bus, **we are limited to 40 people on the trip (St. James Parishioners get first preference).** There will be a modest charge of **\$40 per person** for the pilgrimage.

At 10:30 am, we will begin our guided tour of the Basilica. Following the tour, which should last about an hour and fifteen minutes, there will be some time for private prayer, or to frequent the Basilica gift shop. We will then board the bus at approximately 12:25 pm for our drive to the Cathedral of St. Peter in Chains, our Cathedral, in downtown Cincinnati.



Upon our arrival at St. Peter in Chains, we will enjoy a boxed lunch in the Cathedral Undercroft, followed by a guided tour of the Cathedral. There again will be some time for private prayer, after the tour, or to look around the Cathedral on our own before boarding the bus to return to St. James by approximately 4 pm.

If you are interested in going to this Day Pilgrimage, please fill out the form in today's bulletin and send to the parish office with your \$40 for the trip (make checks payable to St. James). The charge covers the cost of the bus, the boxed lunch and the tour fees at the Cathedrals. We cannot accommodate more than 40 people, and slots for the trip are first come first served with St. James Parishioners getting first preference.

Preparing for Divine Mercy Sunday –April 8



Image of The Divine Mercy and Its Promises

Jesus wants every soul to know about this Image, which is to remind us “to trust in Him and be merciful to others” (*Diary*, 342). Our Lord attached special promises to venerating the Image of The Divine Mercy (by showing deep religious respect toward it because of the person it represents), promises such as eternal salvation, the grace of a happy death, and of all other possible graces which people will ask of Him with trust (*Diary*, 48). The Image speaks to the heart on a level deeper than mere words. As [St.] Pope John Paul II once said, “Anyone can look at this Image of the Merciful Jesus and hear in the depths of his own soul what [St.] Faustina heard: ‘Fear nothing; I am always with you’ (*Diary*, 586). And if this person responds with a sincere heart, ‘Jesus, I trust in You,’ he will find comfort in all his anxieties and fears.” Attend Holy Mass on Divine Mercy Sunday *in a state of grace* and receive Holy Communion with great trust in His Mercy and obtain “complete forgiveness of sins *and* punishment” (*Diary*, 699). Child Protection Policy—Protecting God’s Children:

New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY, when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. **St. James’ next workshop is Wednesday, April 25, 2018 at 6 pm.** See our web page for info, pre-registration and additional workshops at other locations.

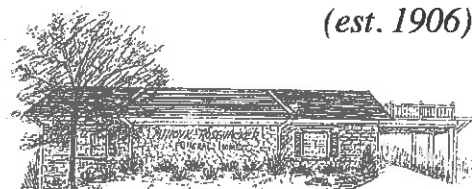
