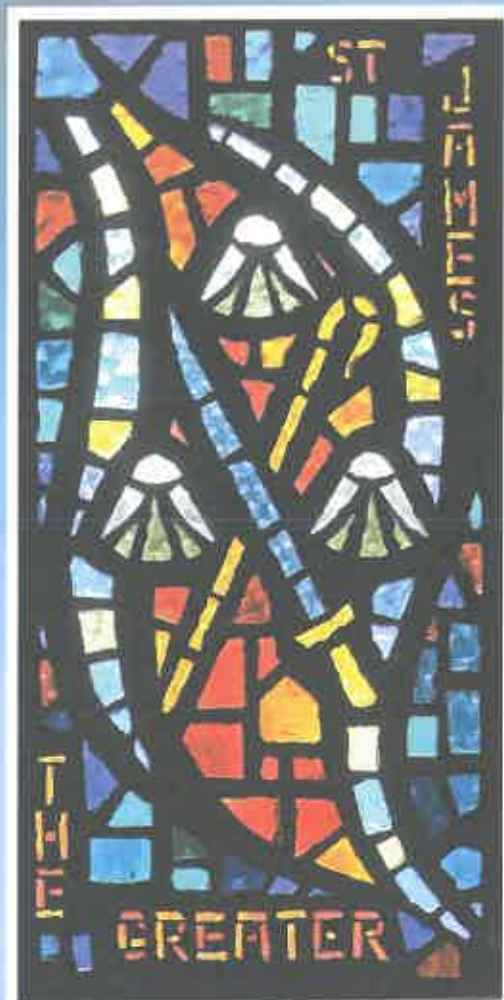

Parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Program, preferably 2 months prior to the birth of the child. The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Seniors' Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

NEW PARISHIONERS – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

Preparing for May 20: Each Sunday during the Easter season, we will be using hymns that will be part of our big anniversary celebration on May 20. These selections are not new to us, but they haven't been used as frequently as other hymns. By using them all through the season, we will be getting more familiar with them and this will allow us to sing with very strong voices on May 20. Especially look for *Laudate, Laudate Dominum* and *Let us Sing to the Lord* (which was written for the parish's 150th anniversary).



As part of our year-long celebration, interesting facts about St. James Parish will be in the bulletin. We will count up to 175 in honor of the Parish's 175th Anniversary!

70. 1956 saw the addition of a north wing to the 1912 school building and work on the cafeteria had begun.
71. Indicative of the generosity of the parishioners, the \$90,000.00 debt for the school was paid off in 4 years.
72. By 1961 everyone realized that the church no longer was adequate for the parish. People were standing outside trying to hear the Mass each Sunday. A new church was designed and the basement was begun.
73. On Easter Sunday, 1962, Father Harold Thorburn celebrated the first Mass in the "temporary" basement church, which would serve the parish until November, 1980. This basement church cost \$262,000.00.

New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY, when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. 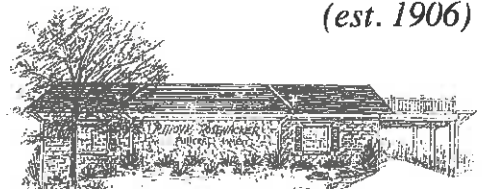
