CHANGE OF ADDRESS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to**

see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement. Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will on the left side of the screen. 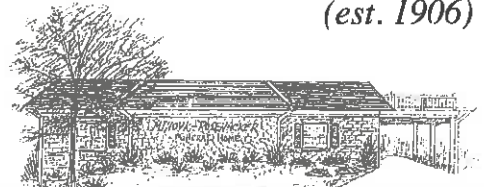
