Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

**NEW PARISHIONERS** – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

**CHANGE OF ADDRESS** – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

The Most Reverend Dennis M. Schnurr, Archbishop of Cincinnati Presiding.

A reception follows in the church hall.

**Preparing for May 20:** Each Sunday during the Easter season, we will be using hymns that will be part of our big anniversary celebration on May 20. These selections are not new to us, but they haven't been used as frequently as other hymns. By using them all through the season, we will be getting more familiar with them and this will allow us to sing with very strong voices on May 20. Especially look for *Laudate, Laudate Dominum* and *Let us Sing to the Lord* (which was written for the parish's 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary).



As part of our year-long celebration, interesting facts about St. James Parish will be in the bulletin. We will count up to 175 in honor of the Parish's 175th Anniversary!

79. When Father Victor C. Koegel became pastor in 1969 the growth in the parish was significant. Expanding housing developments brought more families to Saint James.

80. The Parish reached over 2500 families with 1400 students in grades 2 to 8 in the school.

81. This made the parish one of the largest in the Archdiocese and the school was the largest Catholic grade school in Ohio.

82. A monthly parish magazine, the "HUB", was established to provide a means of conveying information to the parish.

83. Parishes were working hard to implement the teachings of the Second Vatican Council. In 1972 the basement church was renovated so the congregation would be closer to the altar and actually seated all around the sanctuary.

84. Parish Councils (now called Pastoral Councils) were developing along with all the other parish structures and organizations that make up a modern parish.

85. In 1974 Reverend Robert Stricker was appointed co-pastor with Father Koegel. This was an experiment in parish leadership across the archdiocese which did not endure. Father Stricker left Saint James in 1977 and Father Koegel remained as pastor until 1981.

### Child Protection Policy—Protecting God’s Children:

**New volunteers** must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY, when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. 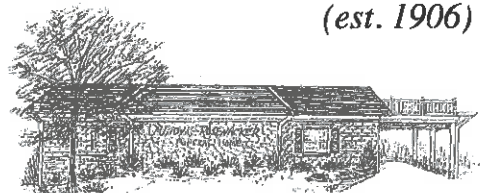
