Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

NEW PARISHIONERS – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

Fr. Bryan T. Reif Introduction



Hello Good People of St. James! Please allow me to introduce myself. My name is Fr. Bryan T. Reif, and I typically go by Fr. Bryan. I am very grateful to have been assigned to St. James the Greater Parish in White Oak as your new Parochial Vicar (what they used to call Associate Pastor). Let me tell you that I am excited to be with all of you, and I am grateful to Archbishop Schnurr Bishop Binzer, the Priests' Personnel Board, and Fr. Nolker for this new assignment.

Let me tell you a little about myself. I was ordained a priest on May 19, 2001 by Archbishop Pilarczyk, and have been serving as a priest for 16 years. My first assignment was as Associate Pastor at St. Dominic in Delhi. From there I went to serve as Associate Pastor at St. Maximillian Kolbe Parish in Liberty Township. I took my first Pastorate in 2005, and served 6 years as Pastor of Holy Trinity Parish in Batavia while at the same time serving as Pastor of St. Ann Parish in Williamsburg, Ohio. During my time in Batavia and Williamsburg, I got sick, and took a medical leave for six months, and upon getting well lived with Fr. Nolker for two months here at St. James in 2012, after which I served as Parochial Vicar at St. Ignatius for three years. During my time at St. I's, I also accepted a position as Temporary Parochial Administrator of St. Bartholomew Parish while the Pastor was on sabbatical for three months, and as Temporary Parochial Administrator of St. Antoninus, while the Pastor was away for Sabbatical, after which he then transferred to the Archdiocese for the Military Services. I was then named as Pastor of St. Antoninus, and have served there as Pastor, until being named Parochial Vicar here at St. James.

I look forward to meeting all of you, but please be forewarned, and I thank you in advance for understanding, that I have never been good with names. Please do feel free to tell me your names, as I may need to hear them several times before names and faces begin to click in my brain. Also, I am an introvert and shy by nature, so please feel free to approach me if I do not take the initiative. I do want to meet you, but sometimes I do struggle in crowds and in new situations. I look forward to the many blessings our God is going to grant to our parish, and I look forward to sharing in them with all of you.

VIRTUS®—Child Protection—Update

Child Protection Policy—Protecting God's Children:

New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW)

CLOW takes place during the 10 AM Sunday Mass each week (except for five Sundays-Christmas, Easter, First Communion, Wedding Anniversary and Festival). CLOW is a wonderful opportunity for our 1st through 4th grade parishioners to experience the Liturgy of the Word in a way that is appropriate to their age group. When Opening Prayer is finished, the celebrant invites the children forward and, after a special blessing, the children process together downstairs to the Church Hall. Our children are led by a group of dedicated adult and high school volunteers in hearing the Scripture readings and a reflection, and participating in praying the Creed and the General Intercessions. The children then return to their families during the Offertory of the Mass.

Children younger than the 1st Grade are welcome to join the other children for CLOW, but they must be

accompanied by a parent. CLOW does not take the place of Mass; it is part of the Mass, and enables young children to participate in the Mass more fully.

Volunteers as leaders, lectors, cantors and hospitality servers are always welcome. The commitment is half-an-hour every fifth week. Please prayerfully consider serving St. James Parish in this capacity. The coordinator for this program is Mrs. Carole Ann Yeazell (385-5163).

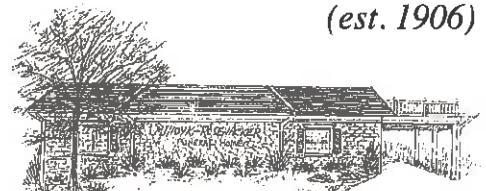
