## Tour of the Church

### Blessed Sacrament Chapel

120. This area provides a quiet place for private prayer before the Blessed Sacrament. The marble and granite of the sanctuary are used again for the floor. The arches of the altar are reflected in the arches of the front wall and on the base for the tabernacle. This helps express the connection between the celebrated Eucharist at the altar and the reserved Eucharist.
121. The tabernacle is 3' high and sits on a granite, marble and wood column. The white marble base has 12 sides representing the 12 Apostles. There are four sides to the column representing the 4 Gospels which reveal Christ to us. The tabernacle was originally used at the Holy Spirit Chapel of the Fenwick Club downtown. (The Fenwick was a residence and athletic club for men at the site of the present Procter and Gamble headquarters.)
122. The primary image in this large round window is the Host above the Chalice of Salvation. Behind it is a red cross with a golden sunburst suggesting the glory of the Sacrament.
123. The Blessed Sacrament Chapel window was designed by Damien Marcione in 2013.
124. The architect for the 2013 remodel, David Sweeney, designed the ceiling and walls in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel and the ambo and wall behind the sanctuary. These were made by Wittrock Wood Carvers, Cincinnati, Ohio.

## VIRTUS®—Child Protection—Update

### Child Protection Policy—Protecting God’s Children:

**New volunteers** must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY, when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. 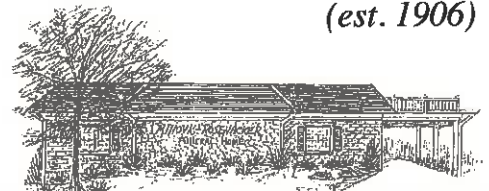
