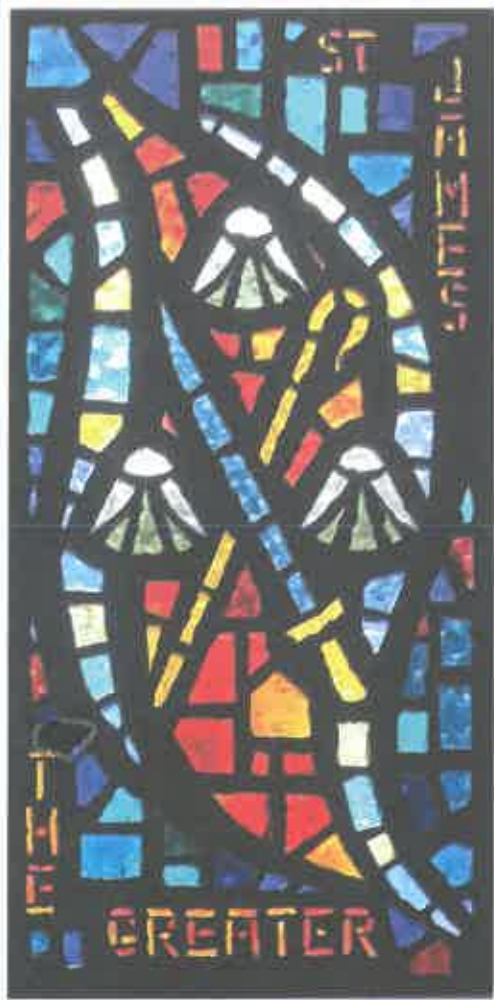

Parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Program, preferably 2 months prior to the birth of the child. The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Seniors' Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

**NEW PARISHIONERS** – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

**CHANGE OF ADDRESS** – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

## Tour of the Church

### Shrine Area next to the Blessed Sacrament Chapel

- 125.** This shrine area is dedicated to Saint James. The painting depicts Saint James just before he is called by Jesus to be a disciple. He is bringing in the last catch before going to clean and mend his nets. Jesus is approaching on the shore of the Sea of Galilee. Soon they will meet and James' life will be forever changed. The light surrounding Jesus is slowly overtaking James as will the call to "Come, follow me." John McCoy painted *The Call of Saint James*.

#### The Scripture

- 126.** *As Jesus passed along the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting a net into the sea – for they were fishermen. And Jesus said to them, "Follow me and I will make you fish for people." And immediately they left their nets and followed him. As he went a little farther, he saw James son of Zebedee and his brother John, who were in their boat mending the nets. Immediately he called them; and they left their father Zebedee in the boat with the hired men, and followed him. (Mark 1:16-19).*

- 127.** There is a change in the weather in the picture. Close behind Jesus is the sun. Light in the picture is synonymous with Jesus. The upper left is darker because Jesus has not arrived there yet.

## VIRTUS®—Child Protection—Update

### Child Protection Policy—Protecting God’s Children:

**New volunteers** must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY, when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. **St. James’ next workshop is Thursday, August 23, 2018 at 6 pm.** See our web page for info, preregistration and additional workshops at other locations.

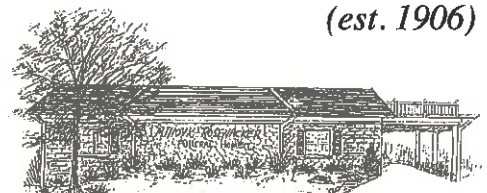
