MARRIAGES – Arrangements should be made through the Parish Office at least six months before any other planning. Pre-Cana Conference, FOCCUS, Engaged Encounter or Equivalent, programs are required.

INFANT BAPTISMS – The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd Sunday of each month at the noon Mass and on the 4th Sunday of each month at 1:30 p.m. (outside of Mass). Parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Program, preferably 2 months prior to the birth of the child. The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Seniors' Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

NEW PARISHIONERS – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

BEQUESTS – A bequest to your parish is a way to honor your church and faith of your lifetime. A bequest, included in your will, is exempt from estate and inheritance taxes, and reduces the amount of the estate to be taxed. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

Tour of the Church

The Church Windows

- 132.** While they were installed 33 years apart, the stained glass windows were all made by Marcione Studios, Canton, Ohio. The Holy Trinity, Eucharist and the series on the sacraments and the Church year were installed with the building of the church in 1980. They had been designed by Frank Marcione, founder of the studio. He was a graduate of the Cleveland Institute of Art and was a master in several fields but especially stained glass and mosaics. The St. James, St. Peter and St. Paul windows were designed by Damien Marcione in 2013.

The Blessed Trinity-The large window on the east side above the altar

- 133.** The gold equal-sided triangle borrows from one of the oldest representations of the Trinity. It signifies the unity of God and it has three equal sides and three equal angles to represent the three equal Persons of the Trinity.
- 134.** God the Father is represented by a hand in the act of creation.
- 135.** God the Son is represented by the Lamb of God, symbolic of the act of redemption. The red field represents the shedding of Jesus' blood surmounted by the cross and the white flag of victory. The red flowing from the Lamb to the brown sphere (the earth) at the lower left represents the salvation of the world through the sacrifice of Jesus.
- 136.** God the Holy Spirit is represented by the dove in front of a red field depicting the sanctifying power of the Holy Spirit. The seven small flames represent the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit.

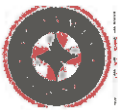

VIRTUS®—Child Protection—Update

Child Protection Policy—Protecting God’s Children:

New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY, when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab, and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. **St. James’ next workshop is Tuesday, September 11, 2018 at 6 pm.** See our web page for info, pre-registration and additional workshops at other locations.

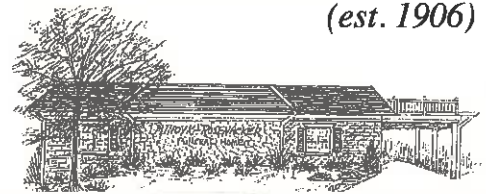
