

143. The chariot is symbolic of Elijah who was taken into heaven by the fiery chariot. The crown is a symbol of victory. The footprints in the lower right corner are signs of the Resurrection.





Pentecost

144. The descending dove is the most familiar representation of the Holy Spirit. The red flames are the tongues of fire that descended on the apostles. The ship is an ancient symbol for the Church, carrying the faithful through all conditions of life. The shell represents Baptism which makes us part of the Church.

New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY, when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement. Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. 


