MARRIAGES – Arrangements should be made through the Parish Office at least six months before any other planning. Pre-Cana Conference, FOCCUS, Engaged Encounter or Equivalent, programs are required.

INFANT BAPTISMS – The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd Sunday of each month at the noon Mass and on the 4th Sunday of each month at 1:30 p.m. (outside of Mass). Parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Program, preferably 2 months prior to the birth of the child. The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Seniors' Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

NEW PARISHIONERS – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

BEQUESTS – A bequest to your parish is a way to honor your church and faith of your lifetime. A bequest, included in your will, is exempt from estate and inheritance taxes, and reduces the amount of the estate to be taxed. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

Tour of the Church

The Church Windows

The Eucharist *The large window on the west side above the font*

- 137.** The central figure is a host inscribed with the "I.H.S.," an abbreviation for "Jesus, Homium Salvator" – "Jesus, Savior of men" and the chalice below it. The red flowing downward indicates the redemptive blood of Christ in the sacrament. The large red cross recalls the sacrifice of Calvary.
- 138.** The grapes and wheat depict the elements of the Eucharist, bread and wine. The bundle of sticks in the lower right represents the Old Testament sacrifice of Abraham. At the far right, the sacrifice of Melchisedech is recalled by loaves and a jug for wine. The twelve crosses around the center represent the apostles. The green leaves in the upper right and lower left signify the spiritual life which is nourished with the Eucharist.



The Church Year – *Smaller windows on the east side near Hubble Rd. (from the left by the door)*

Advent

- 139.** The four candles form the Advent wreath. The "M" represents Mary and the red crosses represent the apostles.

Christmas

- 140.** The Chi Rho is a sacred monogram for Jesus formed by the first two letters of the Greek word for Christ. The crib or manger and the star of Bethlehem are the most familiar symbols of Christ's nativity. The staff represents St. Joseph and the shepherds.

Child Protection Policy—Protecting God’s Children:

New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY, when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. 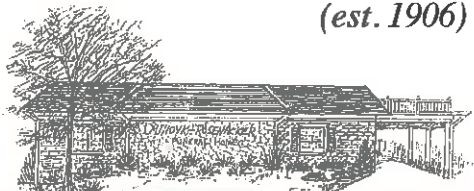
