Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS OR PARISHIONER STATUS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

Recent Deaths

Fasting and Abstinence



Good Friday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat and meat products. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding from age 14 onwards.



Trust in The Divine Mercy—The Last Hope of Salvation

Trust—and nothing more—is what the Lord asks us to bring to Divine Mercy Sunday in order “to receive the whole ocean of His mercy” (*Diary*, 1520, 1578). “The graces of My Mercy are drawn by means of one vessel only, and that is—trust. The more a soul trusts, the more it will receive” (*Diary*, 1578). Christ promised an exceptional abundance of graces—a complete renewal of Baptism—to those who receive Holy Communion in a state of grace with great trust in His Mercy on Divine Mercy Sunday. “Souls perish in spite of My bitter Passion. I am giving them the last hope of salvation, that is, recourse to My Mercy. If they will not adore My mercy, they will perish for all eternity” (*Diary*, 965, 998). So Our Lord’s promise of complete forgiveness is both a reminder and a call. He is waiting for us to turn to Him with trust. And it is a call for all to be washed clean in His Love through the mercy miracles of Confession and Holy Communion. He is offering us a new start. A family’s tax and income information can either be scanned and emailed or sent via mail to the company directly. **The deadline for applications for St. James tuition assistance is April 15, 2019 for the 2019-2020 school year.** If you have applied for aid for a high school and also want to be considered for St. James, you will need to upload your 2018 tax information before the deadline. You do not need to reapply; you just need to update your information. This

is also the process if you applied for the Archdiocesan Financial Aid. Just update your 2018 information before April 15th so your results will be sent to us to be considered for parish aid. The application can be completed at <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3XHJJ>.

Tuesday, March 26 - Lent: A Historical Perspective



with Dr. Susan McGurgan. As the first installment of three Lenten Series speakers being held in the Church Hall at 7:00 PM, Dr. McGurgan will speak on the origins of Lent and how of customs, prayer, and practice have changed over the years and how the disciplines of the past may help us in our Lenten journey. Dr. Susan McGurgan is the Director of the Lay Pastoral Ministry Program at the Athenaeum of Ohio/Mount St. Mary's Seminary and holds the rank of Associate Professor of Pastoral Theology. She earned a MA in Religion from the Athenaeum and a Doctorate in Preaching from Seabury-Western Theological Seminary. She has served on the faculty of the Athenaeum since 1999. In addition to administrative duties, she teaches Church History, Evangelization and the Capstone to lay students and Homiletics II to Permanent Deacons. She has published in the areas of preaching and lay ministry and is currently researching and

writing in the connected areas of memory, gratitude and hope. She is a member of the Cathedral parish and serves on the Cathedral RCIA team.

Tuesday, April 2 - Lent: A Liturgical Perspective

Presenter: Jeremy Helms, former music director at St. Maximilian Kolbe and former chairperson of the Archdiocesan Worship Commission will speak on the liturgies of Lent and the rites, and how they prepare us all to celebrate the Easter Mysteries.

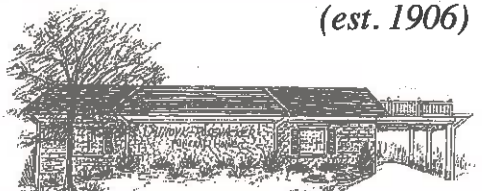
