Child Protection Policy—Protecting God's Children: **New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching.** For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish

Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to**

complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). *This is a one-time requirement.* Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW)

CLOW takes place during the 10 AM Sunday Mass each week (except for five Sundays—Christmas, Easter, First Communion, Wedding Anniversary and Festival).

CLOW is a wonderful opportunity for our 1st through 4th grade parishioners to experience the Liturgy of the Word in a way that is appropriate to their age group. When Opening Prayer is finished, the celebrant invites the children forward and, after a special blessing, the children process together downstairs to the Church Hall. Our children are led by a group of dedicated adult and high school volunteers in hearing the Scripture readings and a reflection, and participating in praying the Creed and the General Intercessions. The children then return to their families during the Offertory of the Mass.

Children younger than the 1st Grade are welcome to join the other children for CLOW, but they must be accompanied by a parent. CLOW does not take the place of Mass; it is part of the Mass, and enables young children to participate in the Mass more fully.

Volunteers as leaders, lectors, cantors and hospitality servers are always welcome. The commitment is half-hour every fifth week. Please prayerfully consider serving St. James Parish in this capacity. The coordinator for this program is Mrs. Carole Ann Yeazell (385-5163).

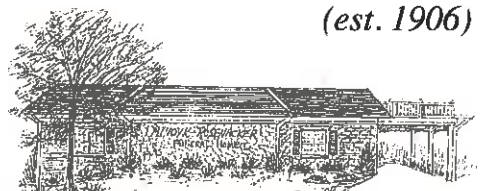
