CHANGE OF ADDRESS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

BEQUESTS – A bequest to your parish is a way to honor your church and faith of your lifetime. A bequest, included in your will, is exempt from estate and inheritance taxes, and reduces the amount of the estate to be taxed. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

Child Protection Policy—Protecting God's Children: For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY**

when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, **EVERYONE** will **NEED** to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). **This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. **New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. ONCE COMPLETED, BE SURE TO READ YOUR MONTHLY BULLETINS TO MAINTAIN YOUR APPROVAL STATUS.** Please be aware that you will have your first bulletin to read shortly after taking the Workshop. **St. James' next workshop is Wednesday, February 22nd. 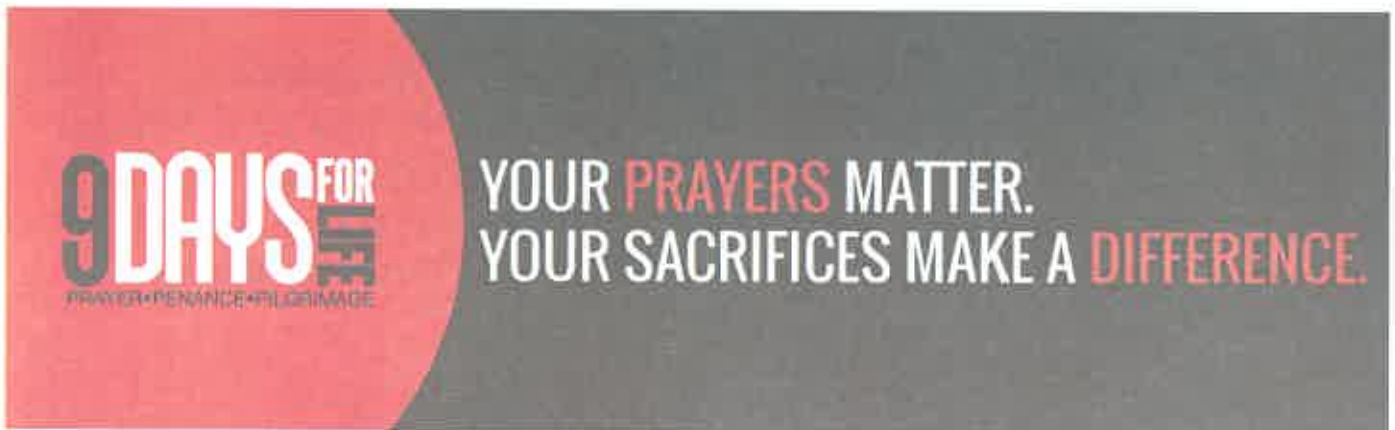

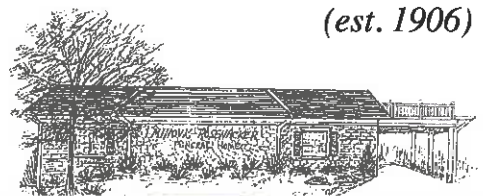
