MARRIAGES - Arrangements should be made through the Parish Office at least six months before any other planning. Pre-Cana Conference, FOCCUS, Engaged Encounter or Equivalent programs are required.

INFANT BAPTISMS - The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd Sunday of each month at the noon Mass and on the 4th Sunday of each month at 1:30 p.m. (outside of Mass). Parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Program, preferably 2 months prior to the birth of the child. The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Seniors' Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

NEW PARISHIONERS - Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS - Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

BEQUESTS - A bequest to your parish is a way to honor your church and faith of your lifetime. A bequest, included in your will, is exempt from estate and inheritance taxes, and reduces the amount of the estate to be taxed. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

Reverend Francis J. Pabisch, Pastor 1851-1856



DR. PABISCH

31. 1851 saw the appointment of the first resident pastor, Reverend Francis J. Pabisch. A four room, two-story building was added to the church to serve as sacristy and residence for Father Pabisch.

32. Fr. Pabisch wrote a constitution for the parish, which laid out a number of items, including:

- I. a pastor's salary of \$300 per year, plus firewood and altar wine,
- II. the right of the pastor to pass judgment on the qualities of a school teacher and
- III. the obligation to rent at least one seat in church at the cost of \$1 per year.

33. The oil painting, "Old St. James Church in White Oak" that hangs in the Parish Office is attributed to Fr. Pabisch. There isn't a signature on it, but Fr. Pabisch was reputed to have painted a number of oils. Fr. Pabisch is also thought to have painted it because of the painting's age, subject matter and quality.

VIRTUS®—Child Protection—Update

Child Protection Policy—Protecting God's Children:

New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. St. James' next workshop is **Wednesday, February 21, 2018 at 6 pm.** See our web page for info, preregistration and additional workshops at other locations.

Archdiocesan Financial Aide - The Archdiocese of Cincinnati is now accepting applications for financial aide for the 2018-2019 school year through the Catholic Education Foundation. In order to apply, families must complete the FACTS Grant and Aid Application.

(FACTS is the tuition collection program used at St. James already.) **Applications must be received by January 31, 2018.** Eligible families can be awarded up to \$1,000 per student to attend St. James next year. Funds will be distributed based on the assessed financial need of families and will be without distinguishing between families based on religion or parishioner status. For Parish Assistance: When you have your 2017 Tax Returns, upload them to FACTS so you will also be eligible for Parish Assistance. **The Deadline for St. James Parish is April 15, 2018.**

To bring attention to the Anniversary of *Roe vs. Wade*, a January 22, 1973, US Supreme Court decision which affirmed the legalization of a woman's right to abortion in the US, we will be displaying **Respect Life posters made by the St. James school students this WEEKEND in the Church Hall after all the Masses.** This year's Respect Life theme is "Be Not Afraid," the children used their imaginations and creativity to express their interpretations of this theme. Some of the themes are Kindness, Respect our Planet, Respect All Life, Abortion, Respect People with Disabilities, etc. We also encourage everyone to take time on January 22 and to pray a Hail Mary for LIFE.



Archbishop Schnurr Urges Your Support of the Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act: This legislation, which prohibits abortion after 20 weeks gestation on the scientific evidence that fetuses can feel pain by that point, passed the House of Representatives on October 3, and is now in committee in the U.S. Senate as S.1922. Please consider using simple templates found at www.catholiccincinnati.org/ministries-offices/respect-life-2/unborn-act to write our Senators, urging them to support this common-sense legislation that in many polls, 60% of Americans also support. You can also sign letters in the church undercroft after all Masses this weekend.

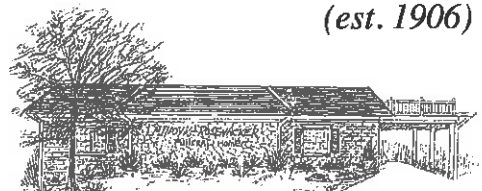
