Parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Program, preferably 2 months prior to the birth of the child. The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Council Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

NEW PARISHIONERS – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS OR PARISHIONER STATUS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

BEQUESTS – A bequest to your parish is a way to honor your church and faith of your lifetime. A bequest, included in your will, is exempt from estate and inheritance taxes, and reduces the amount of the estate to be taxed. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

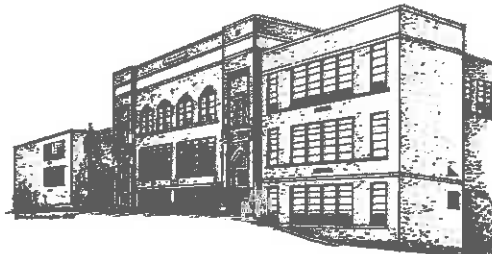

St. James School Update

The Week Ahead – Catholic Schools Week is an exciting time for our students and staff to celebrate how blessed we are to be a part of the St. James community. There is a theme for each day of the week including many activities: **Monday is Faith in Action Day** in which the students will participate in a service project and participate in a student-led prayer service. **Tuesday is Community Day** in which Mass will be celebrated at the cathedral with representative families from each parish school. Additionally, The Children's Theatre will present *Rumpelstiltskin* for grades K-4 and *Rosa Parks* for grades 5-8. **Wednesday is A Day of Thanksgiving** in which students will attend an all-school Mass and make thank-you notes, cards, etc. to thank their parents for their Catholic education. **Thursday is School Staff Day** when we will celebrate our dedicated staff with a luncheon. **Friday is Kids Day**, when we celebrate all of our wonderful students with the *My Nose Turns Red* program for grades K-4 and exciting games of dodgeball and *Minute to Win It* for grades 5-8!

Archdiocesan Financial Aid – The Archdiocese of Cincinnati is now accepting applications for Financial Aid for the 2019-2020 school year through the Catholic Education Foundation tuition aid program which is funded by the One Faith, One Hope, One Love Capital Campaign. In order to apply, families must complete the FACTS Grant and Aid Application. (FACTS is the tuition collection program used at St. James already). **Applications must be received by January 31, 2019.** Eligible families can be awarded up to \$1,000 per student to attend St. James next year. Funds will be distributed based on the assessed financial need of families and will be without distinguishing between families based on religion or parishioner status. 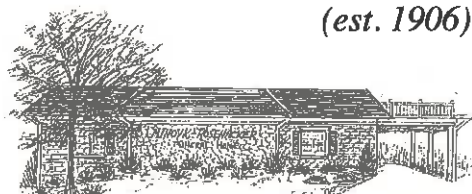
