CHANGE OF ADDRESS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

- 149.** The keys represent the power given to the Church to forgive sins. The lamb symbolizes Christ. The hand represents the priest's raised hand while giving absolution. The staff symbolizes Jesus the Good Shepherd who cares for and protects His people.

- 150.** The jug represents the oil used in the sacrament. The red crosses are the five senses and the crown is the symbol of victory and eternal life. The bird illustrates the soul of the departed ascending into heaven.

- 151.** The Book of Gospels is shown with a priest's red stole around it. The chalice symbolizes the power given to priests to celebrate the Mass. The red flames are the power of the Holy Spirit.

Child Protection Policy—Protecting God’s Children:

New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY, when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. 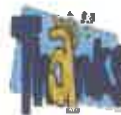

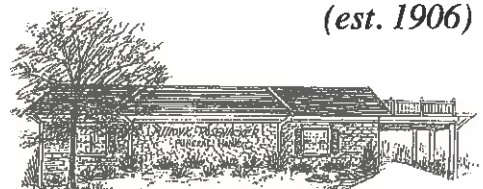
