MARRIAGES – Arrangements should be made through the Parish Office at least six months before any other planning. Pre-Cana Conference, FOCCUS, Engaged Encounter or Equivalent, programs are required.

INFANT BAPTISMS – The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd Sunday of each month at the noon Mass and on the 4th Sunday of each month at 1:30 p.m. (outside of Mass). Parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Program, preferably 2 months prior to the birth of the child. The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Seniors' Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

NEW PARISHIONERS – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

BEQUESTS – A bequest to your parish is a way to honor your church and faith of your lifetime. A bequest, included in your will, is exempt from estate and inheritance taxes, and reduces the amount of the estate to be taxed. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

Who is Saint James the Greater?

1. James is one of the twelve apostles and the brother of John, who is also an apostle.
2. In Hebrew his name would have been Jacob. The founders of St. James church spoke German and named their church St. Jacobus.

That's why the stone tablet (which is from the old Cheviot Rd. Church) located at the bottom of the main stairwell is in German.

3. He was a fisherman from Galilee with his father Zebedee, his brother John, and the workmen they employed.

4. In Mark 3:17, James and John are called the "Sons of Thunder," which might be a nickname based on their forthrightness in wanting to call down "fire from heaven" in retaliation for a Samaritan town not welcoming Jesus or because they asked Jesus if they could sit on his right and left in the Kingdom.

VIRTUS®—Child Protection—Update

Child Protection Policy—Protecting God's Children:

New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to

check on your status. If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY, when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). *This is a one-time requirement.* Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. St. James' next workshop is **Wednesday, February 21, 2018 at 6 pm.** See our web page for info, pre-registration and additional workshops at other locations.

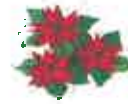

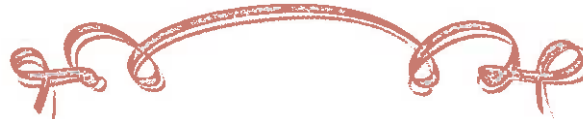

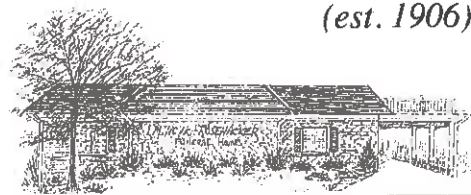
