CHANGE OF ADDRESS or Parishioner Status—Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

BEQUESTS—A bequest to your parish is a way to honor your church and faith of your lifetime. A bequest, included in your will, is exempt from estate and inheritance taxes, and reduces the amount of the estate to be taxed. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

Part of that request is to be able to verify that a person is an “active member” of St. James the Greater Parish. An “active member” of this parish is one who: **1.** Is properly registered and on the parish census. **2.** Faithfully attends Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. **3.** Participates in parish activities when possible. **4.** Uses the parish envelope system.

NOTE: An adult child living at home should register as themselves or please notify the Parish Office when they no longer live at home with the parents.

While assessments of an inquirer's status will be made individually, the above are the main factors that will be considered in making that determination. **If you would like to update your information and/or inquire about your membership status, or if you do not receive our Quarterly Parish Life Newsletter or yearly Sunday contribution envelopes, you are inactive in our parish data base. 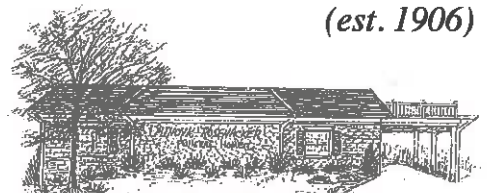
