MARRIAGES – Arrangements should be made through the Parish Office at least six months before any other planning. Pre-Cana Conference, FOCCUS, Engaged Encounter or Equivalent programs are required.

INFANT BAPTISMS – The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd Sunday of each month at the noon Mass and on the 4th Sunday of each month at 1:30 p.m. (outside of Mass). Parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Program, preferably 2 months prior to the birth of the child. The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Seniors' Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

NEW PARISHIONERS – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

BEQUESTS – A bequest to your parish is a way to honor your church and faith of your lifetime. A bequest, included in your will, is exempt from estate and inheritance taxes, and reduces the amount of the estate to be taxed. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

Reverend John H. Schoenfeld, Pastor 1875-1912

- 42.** Father John H. Schoenfeld became pastor in 1875 and stayed until his death 37 years later.
- 43.** In the early 1900s, the parish started a yearly picnic that was held close to the feast of Saint James. It was held at Gutzwiller's Grove. Food was prepared by the ladies of the parish. The picnic was later moved to the church grounds and then to Stricker's Grove.
- 44.** In 1906, Fr. Schoenfeld invited the Sisters of St. Francis from Oldenburg, Indiana to staff the school. Sister Lucina Fries arrived for the beginning of the school year in 1907 with another sister. A home on Burnt School House Road was bought as a residence for the Sisters.
- 45.** By the turn of the century, Saint James had outgrown its school. The 1874 two-room structure was inadequate for many reasons. Father Schoenfeld began the work on the new school, but died before it was completed. He is buried in St. James Cemetery.

Fasting and Abstinence



Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat and meat products. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding from age 14 onwards.

Child Protection Policy—Protecting God's Children:

New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY, when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. **St. James' next workshop is Wednesday, February 21, 2018 at 6 pm.** See our web page for info, preregistration and additional workshops at other locations.

NATURALIZATION CEREMONY

On **Friday, February 23, 2018 at 11:00 a.m.** St. James will have the privilege of hosting a Naturalization Ceremony for individuals who will become new American citizens. This is our 18th year to sponsor this momentous occasion. On this day the Church Hall will become an official court of law presided over by Magistrate Judge Karen L. Litkovitz, who will administer the oath of citizenship. Typically we have up to 100 candidates for citizenship from countries all over the world. This is an important and memorable day for these people, many of whom travel quite a distance to be here.

St. James students participate in the ceremony in a number of ways. The children's choir opens the ceremony with enjoyable music and the St. James Scouting groups help direct the morning's traffic and post both the American and Ohio flags. 7th and 8th Grade students will have the honor of attending the ceremony in conjunction with their study of Citizenship. They will also assist with the morning refreshments, clean up, and provide congratulatory cards to the new citizens. The 8th Grade students may also have the opportunity to hear the story of Sacha Bellman, a member of our community who became a Naturalized citizen. She may do a presentation the week before the ceremony during school hours.

It is inspirational to hear each applicant stand and state their name and country of origin before declaring their Oath of Allegiance to the United States. They make the promise to "support and defend the Constitution and laws of the United States." Finally, they face the United States flag and recite the Pledge of Allegiance for the first time as United States citizens.

With the support of Mr. Fulmer, Fr. Nolker, PTO, the Hospitality Committee, and the staff and teachers of St. James we are proud to show our support to the wider community in which we live. 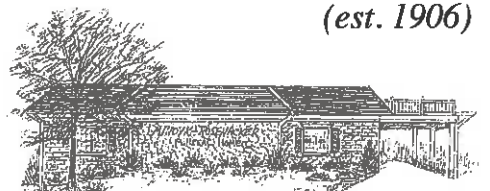
