MARRIAGES – Arrangements should be made through the Parish Office at least six months before any other planning. Pre-Cana Conference, FOCCUS, Engaged Encounter or Equivalent, programs are required.

INFANT BAPTISMS – The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd Sunday of each month at the noon Mass and on the 4th Sunday of each month at 1:30 p.m. (outside of Mass). Parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Program, preferably 2 months prior to the birth of the child. The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Council Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

NEW PARISHIONERS – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS OR PARISHIONER STATUS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

BEQUESTS – A bequest to your parish is a way to honor your church and faith of your lifetime. A bequest, included in your will, is exempt from estate and inheritance taxes, and reduces the amount of the estate to be taxed. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

St. James Parish Tuition Assistance St. James will be utilizing FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment to determine financial need for tuition assistance here at St. James. FACTS provides an online application for families. A family's tax and income information can either be scanned and emailed or sent via mail to the company directly. The deadline for applications for St. James tuition assistance is April 15, 2019, for the 2019-2020 school year. If you have applied for aid for a high school and also want to be considered for St. James, you will need to upload your 2018 tax information before the deadline. You do not need to reapply; you just need to update your information. This is also the process if you applied for the Archdiocesan Financial Aid. Just update your 2018 information before April 15th so your results will be sent to us to be considered for parish aid. 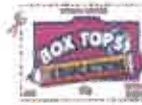

Naturalization Ceremony

On Friday, February 22, 2019, at 11:00 a.m., St. James will have the privilege of hosting a Naturalization Ceremony for individuals who will become new American citizens. This is our 19th year to sponsor this momentous occasion. On this day the Church Hall will become an official court of law presided over by Magistrate Judge Karen L. Litkovitz, who will administer the oath of citizenship. Typically, we have up to 100 candidates for citizenship from countries all over the world.

St. James students participate in the ceremony in a number of ways. The children's choir opens the ceremony with enjoyable music and the St. James Scouting groups help direct the morning's traffic and post both the American and Ohio flags. 7th and 8th Grade students will have the honor of attending the ceremony this year. They will also assist with the morning refreshments, cleanup, and provide congratulatory cards to the new citizens.

It is inspirational to hear each applicant stand and state their name and country of origin before declaring their Oath of Allegiance to the United States. They make the promise to "support and defend the Constitution and laws of the United States." Finally, they face the United States flag and recite the Pledge of Allegiance for the first time as United States citizens.

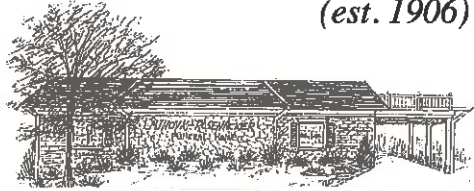
