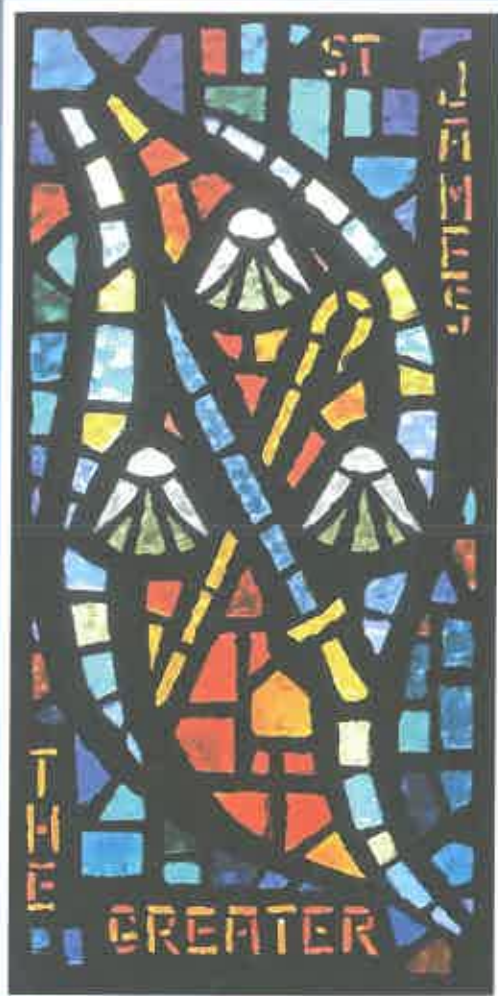
INFANT BAPTISMS – The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd Sunday of each month at the noon Mass and on the 4th Sunday of each month at 1:30 p.m. (outside of Mass). Parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Program, preferably 2 months prior to the birth of the child. The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Seniors' Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

NEW PARISHIONERS – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

Reverend Joseph T. Duerstock, Pastor 1912-1916



46. Father Duerstock followed Father Schoenfeld and completed the school project. In 1912, a new 8-room brick school building was dedicated. It is recorded that parishioners criticized the extravagance of such a large school.

47. By 1943, Saint James School had 225 students and all the classrooms were being used. That sturdy building is the center and heart of our present school.

48. Before leaving Saint James in 1916, Father Duerstock had the interior of the church redone and installed a new high altar.

Fasting and Abstinence



Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat and meat products. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding from age 14 onwards.

DAY PILGRIMAGE TO THE CATHEDRAL BASILICA OF THE ASSUMPTION, AND TO THE CATHEDRAL OF ST. PETER IN CHAINS

Monday, March 12, 2018 – 8:30 AM until Approx. 4 PM

The Group will meet and attend the 8:30 am Mass at St. James. Following Mass, we will board the bus for the trip into Covington, KY, to visit the Basilica of the Assumption, the Cathedral of the Diocese of Covington. Our bus will be provided by Queen City Transportation, and with only one bus, **we are limited to 40 people on the trip (St. James Parishioners get first preference)**. There will be a modest charge of **\$40 per person** for the pilgrimage.

At 10:30 am, we will begin our guided tour of the Basilica. Following the tour, which should last about an hour and fifteen minutes, there will be some time for private prayer, or to frequent the Basilica gift shop. We will then board the bus at approximately 12:25 pm for our drive to the Cathedral of St. Peter in Chains, our Cathedral, in downtown Cincinnati.



Upon our arrival at St. Peter in Chains, we will enjoy a boxed lunch in the Cathedral Undercroft, followed by a guided tour of the Cathedral. There again will be some time for private prayer, after the tour, or to look around the Cathedral on our own before boarding the bus to return to St. James by approximately 4 pm.

If you are interested in going to this Day Pilgrimage, please fill out the form in today's bulletin and send to the parish office with your \$40 for the trip (make checks payable to St. James). The charge covers the cost of the bus, the boxed lunch and the tour fees at the Cathedrals. We cannot accommodate more than 40 people, and slots for the trip are first-come, first-served with St. James Parishioners getting first preference

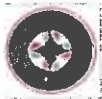

Child Protection Policy—Protecting God’s Children:

New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY, when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. **St. James’ next workshop is Wednesday, February 21, 2018 at 6 pm.** See our web page for info, preregistration and additional workshops at other locations.

NATURALIZATION CEREMONY

On **Friday, February 23, 2018 at 11:00 a.m.** St. James will have the privilege of hosting a Naturalization Ceremony for individuals who will become new American citizens. This is our 18th year to sponsor this momentous occasion. On this day the Church Hall will become an official court of law presided over by Magistrate Judge Karen L. Litkovitz, who will administer the oath of citizenship. Typically, we have up to 100 candidates for citizenship from countries all over the world. This is an important and memorable day for these people, many of whom travel quite a distance to be here.

St. James students participate in the ceremony in a number of ways. The children's choir opens the ceremony with enjoyable music and the St. James Scouting groups help direct the morning's traffic and post both the American and Ohio flags. 7th and 8th Grade students will have the honor of attending the ceremony in conjunction with their study of Citizenship. They will also assist with the morning refreshments, clean up, and provide congratulatory cards to the new citizens. The 8th Grade students may also have the opportunity to hear the story of Sacha Bellman, a member of our community who became a Naturalized citizen. She may do a presentation the week before the ceremony during school hours.

It is inspirational to hear each applicant stand and state their name and country of origin before declaring their Oath of Allegiance to the United States. They make the promise to "support and defend the Constitution and laws of the United States." Finally, they face the United States flag and recite the Pledge of Allegiance for the first time as United States citizens.

With the support of Mr. Fulmer, Fr. Nolker, PTO, the Hospitality Committee, and the staff and teachers of St. James we are proud to show our support to the wider community in which we live. 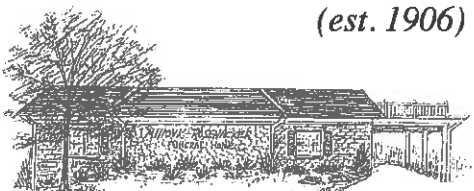
