The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Seniors' Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

**NEW PARISHIONERS** – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

**CHANGE OF ADDRESS** – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

#### **Friday, March 9<sup>th</sup> – Fish Fry**

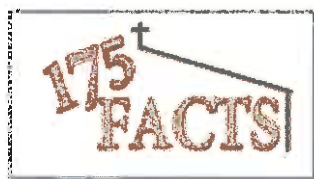

### **Reverend August C. Adelman, Pastor 1916-1920**



**49.** When Father August C. Adelman became pastor in 1916, Saint James was a parish of 175 families. His years at Saint James saw World War I.

**50.** Fr. Adelman also oversaw efforts to pay off the new school building. The 175 families pledged \$8,575.00 and actually gave about \$7,100 over four years.

**51.** There was still a debt of \$17,000 that would remain when Father Henry (Harry) Meyer became pastor in 1920.

## Fasting and Abstinence

**Good Friday** is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat and meat products. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding from age 14 onwards.

## DAY PILGRIMAGE TO THE CATHEDRAL BASILICA OF THE ASSUMPTION, AND TO THE CATHEDRAL OF ST. PETER IN CHAINS **Monday, March 12, 2018 – 8:30 AM until Approx. 4 PM**

The Group will meet and attend the 8:30 am Mass at St. James. Following Mass, we will board the bus for the trip into Covington, KY, to visit the Basilica of the Assumption, the Cathedral of the Diocese of Covington. Our bus will be provided by Queen City Transportation, and with only one bus, **we are limited to 40 people on the trip (St. James Parishioners get first preference)**. There will be a modest charge of **\$40 per person** for the pilgrimage.

At 10:30 am, we will begin our guided tour of the Basilica. Following the tour, which should last about an hour and fifteen minutes, there will be some time for private prayer, or to frequent the Basilica gift shop. We will then board the bus at approximately 12:25 pm for our drive to the Cathedral of St. Peter in Chains, our Cathedral, in downtown Cincinnati.



Upon our arrival at St. Peter in Chains, we will enjoy a boxed lunch in the Cathedral Undercroft, followed by a guided tour of the Cathedral. There again will be some time for private prayer, after the tour, or to look around the Cathedral on our own before boarding the bus to return to St. James by approximately 4 pm.

If you are interested in going to this Day Pilgrimage, please fill out the form in today's bulletin and send to the parish office with your \$40 for the trip (make checks payable to St. James). The charge covers the cost of the bus, the boxed lunch and the tour fees at the Cathedrals. We cannot accommodate more than 40 people, and slots for the trip are first-come, first-served with St. James Parishioners getting first preference.

Our preparation for the Feast of Divine Mercy starts with strengthening our trust in The Divine Mercy and “showing mercy to your neighbors always and everywhere” (*Diary*, 742). **New volunteers** must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY, when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. THANKS to the continued generosity toward the historic One Faith, One Hope, One Love Campaign, our parish's most recent rebate came to \$20,201.20, bringing our total share so far to \$199,279.03. These funds have been applied to the following here at our parish:

- Retiring the debt from church renovation and installation of new school windows, and
- To increase the Perpetual Care Fund for the parish cemetery and building of the Columbarium for the entombment of cremains.
