MARRIAGES – Arrangements should be made through the Parish Office at least six months before any other planning. Pre-Cana Conference, FOCCUS, Engaged Encounter or Equivalent, programs are required.

INFANT BAPTISMS – The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd Sunday of each month at the noon Mass and on the 4th Sunday of each month at 1:30 p.m. (outside of Mass). Parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Program, preferably 2 months prior to the birth of the child. The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Council Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

NEW PARISHIONERS – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS OR PARISHIONER STATUS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

BEQUESTS – A bequest to your parish is a way to honor your church and faith of your lifetime. A bequest, included in your will, is exempt from estate and inheritance taxes, and reduces the amount of the estate to be taxed. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

Fasting and Abstinence



Good Friday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat and meat products. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding from age 14 onwards.

Jesus Christ has promised to the world, through St. Faustina, “**complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.**” These extraordinary graces are available to the faithful through the reception of Holy Communion *in a state of grace* on Divine Mercy Sunday (*Diary*, 699). “**Every soul believing and trusting in My mercy will obtain it**” (*Diary*, 420). FACTS provides an online application for families. A family’s tax and income information can either be scanned and emailed or sent via mail to the company directly. **The deadline for applications for St. James tuition assistance is April 15, 2019, for the 2019-2020 school year.** If you have applied for aid for a high

school and also want to be considered for St. James, you will need to upload your 2018 tax information before the deadline. You do not need to reapply; you just need to update your information. This is also the process if you applied for the Archdiocesan Financial Aid. Just update your 2018 information before April 15th so your results will be sent to us to be considered for parish aid.
