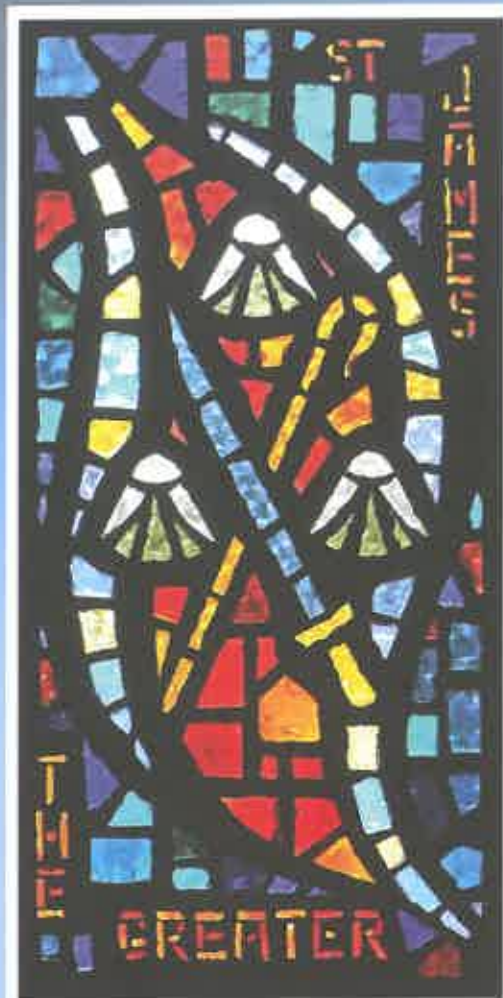

Parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Program, preferably 2 months prior to the birth of the child. The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Seniors' Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

NEW PARISHIONERS – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

Fasting and Abstinence



Good Friday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat and meat products. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding from age 14 onwards.

Virtus—Child Protection— Update

Child Protection Policy—Protecting God’s Children: For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). *This is a one-time requirement.* Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. **New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. ONCE COMPLETED, BE SURE TO READ YOUR MONTHLY BULLETINS TO MAINTAIN YOUR APPROVAL STATUS.** Please be aware that you will have your first bulletin to read shortly after taking the Workshop. **St. James’ next workshop is Wednesday, April 26th, no March Workshop.** See our web page for info, pre-registration and additional workshops at other locations.**



St. James School Update

THE WEEK AHEAD—After school enrichment classes begin this week. Students also begin taking our annual standardized testing. On Friday, 8th grade prayer leaders will visit each classroom for a Lenten prayer. They will do this each Friday during Lent.

ENROLLMENT for 2017-18—St. James is now accepting applications for enrollment for next school year. To register, visit the school’s website at www.stjameswo.org or contact the school office at 741-5333. Be sure to register your child for kindergarten and secure your spot.

Tuition Assistance—St. James will be utilizing FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment to determine financial need for tuition assistance here at St. James. FACTS provides an online application for families. A family’s tax and income information can either be scanned and emailed or sent via mail to the company directly. The deadline for applications for St. James tuition assistance is **April 15, 2017**, for the 2017-2018 school year. If you have applied for aid for a high school and also want to be considered for St. James, you will need to upload your 2016 tax information before the deadline. You do not need to reapply, you just need to update your information. **This is also the process if you applied for the Archdiocesan Financial Aid. Just update your 2016 information before April 15th, so your results will be sent to us to be considered for parish aid.** Complete the application at <https://online.factsmtg.com/signin/3XHJJ>. If you have any questions about tuition assistance or the application process, please contact Amy Klosterman, St. James Parish Business Manager, at 741-5320.

The **John Merritt Scholarships Form** with the criteria necessary are available in the current Parish Life Newsletter which can also be found on our webpage under Resources tab then Publications. Forms are also available in the Parish Office. **Grade School deadline is March 15th.**

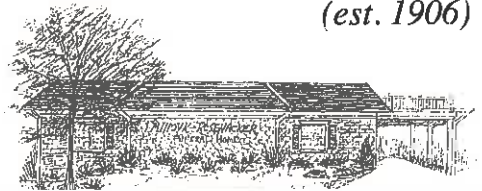
