1944 Great Fire

- 59.** As reported in the Cincinnati Enquirer, there was a fire in the church on December 4, 1944. "An intensely smoky fire of undetermined origin burned out the auditorium floor and pews seating 300 persons in St. James Church, Cheviot and Hubble Roads, White Oak, yesterday causing approximately \$25,000 damage to the 95-year-old brick-walled edifice."
- 60.** The Sisters of St. Francis who lived next door to the church discovered the fire.
- 61.** The floor of the nave and the pews collapsed into the 5-foot crawl space beneath the church. The altars, paintings and statues were badly damaged by water and smoke. The walls, windows and sanctuary were saved.
- 62.** The cause of the fire was attributed to a faulty flue. Masses were celebrated in the school auditorium while the church was rebuilt.
- 63.** Over the next year, the flooring was rebuilt and the whole church redecorated.

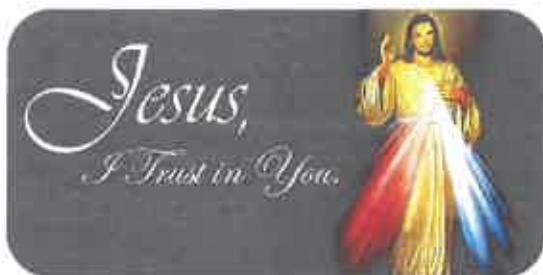

VIRTUS®—Child Protection—Update

Child Protection Policy—Protecting God's Children:

New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY, when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. **St. James' next workshop is Wednesday, April 25, 2018 at 6 pm.** See our web page for info, pre-registration and additional workshops at other locations.

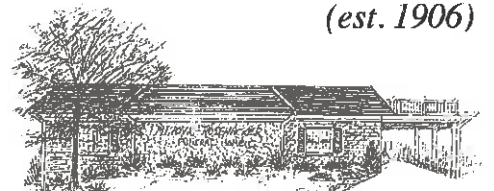
