If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement. Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. ONCE COMPLETED, BE SURE TO READ YOUR MONTHLY BULLETINS TO MAINTAIN YOUR APPROVAL STATUS. Please be aware that you will have your first bulletin to read shortly after taking the Workshop. 
