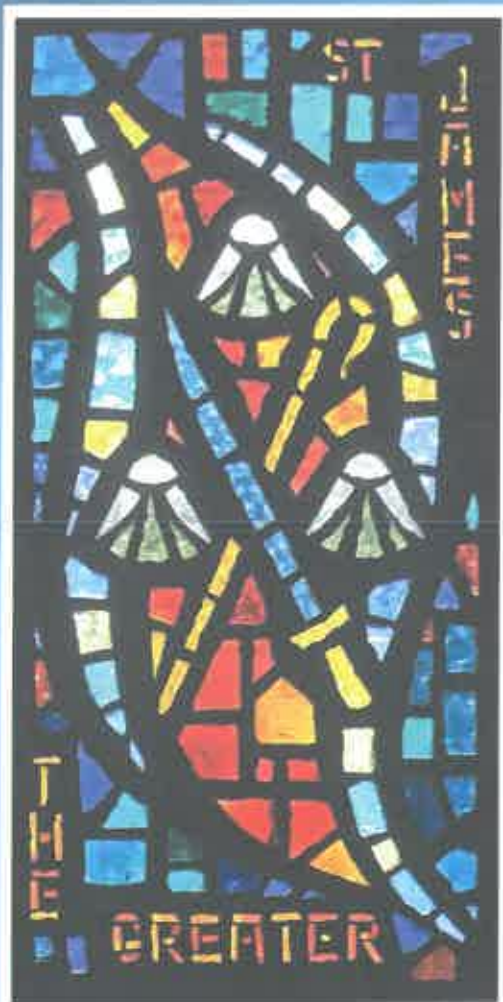
INFANT BAPTISMS – The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd Sunday of each month at the noon Mass and on the 4th Sunday of each month at 1:30 p.m. (outside of Mass). Parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Program, preferably 2 months prior to the birth of the child. The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Seniors' Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

NEW PARISHIONERS – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

Tour of the Church

Confessional

- 107.** To the left of the door to the north sacristy is the confessional. The plaque is a trompe l'oeil painting, to make it look like a wood carving. White tulips surround the main features because they symbolize forgiveness. Artist John McCoy painted it.
- 108.** The central figures come from the Gospel of John 20:19-23. The gold cross in the center symbolizes the Resurrected Jesus who tells His disciples "Receive the Holy Spirit (the white dove in the plaque). Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them and whose sins you retain are retained." The crossed keys are the traditional symbol of the Sacrament of Penance and indicate the Church's power to forgive sins.
- 109.** It's an ordinary part of our Catholic lives to go to Confession and feel God's mercy in our hearts. The plaque celebrates "God's mercy endures forever."

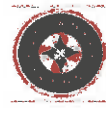
Child Protection Policy—Protecting God’s Children:

New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY, when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. Click and follow the instructions. **St. James’ next workshop is Tuesday, July 10, 2018 at 6 pm.** See our web page for info, pre-registration and additional workshops at other locations.

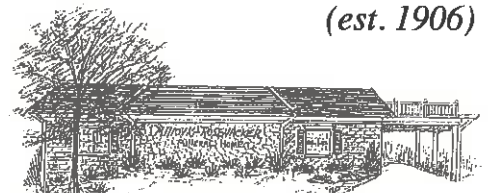
