MARRIAGES – Arrangements should be made through the Parish Office at least six months before any other planning. Pre-Cana Conference, FOCCUS, Engaged Encounter or Equivalent, programs are required.

INFANT BAPTISMS – The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd Sunday of each month at the noon Mass and on the 4th Sunday of each month at 1:30 p.m. (outside of Mass). Parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Program, preferably 2 months prior to the birth of the child. The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Seniors' Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

NEW PARISHIONERS – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

BEQUESTS – A bequest to your parish is a way to honor your church and faith of your lifetime. A bequest, included in your will, is exempt from estate and inheritance taxes, and reduces the amount of the estate to be taxed. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

Posture of James

128. James is leaning back and straining to show how hard the work is. His right foot is visible at the edge of the water. Besides showing how he balanced himself, it also demonstrates the change in St. James' life, as reflected in the lyrics in the hymn *Change Our Hearts*:

- A. *Brought by your hand to the edge of our dreams,
One foot in paradise, one in the waste.*
- B. *Drawn by your promises, still we are lured
by the shadows and the chains we leave behind.*

129. Following Jesus, James will put both feet in paradise, the land.

Son of Thunder

130. In Mark 3:17, James is referred to as the "Son of Thunder." The reference to the James as the "Son of Thunder" can be interpreted that he has a significant temper. It can be interpreted more accurately as an intensity which is shown in his face. Maybe the nickname refers to the way he tries to defend his friends, as he did Jesus when James wanted to call down fire on the Samaritans who would not let Jesus stay in their town on the way to Jerusalem. (Luke 9:52)

Shirtless

131. James is shirtless because of the reference about St. Peter who is fishing when he sees Jesus on the shore. John 21:7 (in the NAB, RSV and Jerusalem) says Peter was naked as he fished and put on clothes to go ashore to Jesus. It seems they didn't wear much when fishing.

Child Protection Policy—Protecting God’s Children:

New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through your VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. You can call the parish office to check on your status. **If you were previously approved with BCI fingerprints ONLY, and have not completed the Selection.com background check, PLEASE call the parish office to see when they expire. Fingerprints for Volunteers are no longer required, BUT if you were approved with fingerprints ONLY, when they become 5 years old, or by December 31, 2018, EVERYONE will NEED to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.** Log into your account, click on the Toolbox tab and the Selection.com background check will be on the left side of the screen. THANKS to the continued generosity toward the historic One Faith, One Hope, One Love Campaign, our parish's most recent rebate came to **\$24,271.20**, bring our total share so far to **\$423,550.30**. These funds have been/will be applied to the following here at St. James:

* **Retiring the debt from parish church renovation and installation of new school windows, and**

* **Increase Perpetual Care Fund for parish cemetery and building of a Columbarium for entombment of cremains.**

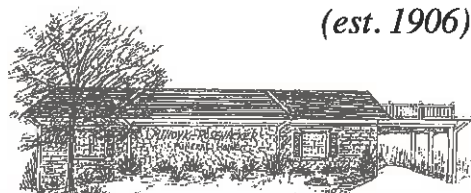
