Taize prayer - This evening we have exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and a prayer service using the music of the Taize monastery in France.

Tuesday, March 3
6:00 – 9:00 p.m.

The Light Is On For You – Confessions are heard in all parishes in our archdiocese on this night. This event isn't just another time for confessions but is especially designed for those who have been away from the sacrament for a long time or are returning to the practice of their faith. We will begin an hour earlier than other parishes to accommodate people on their way home from work.

7:00 p.m.


The Way of the Cross – a reflection on the Passion and Death of Jesus.
