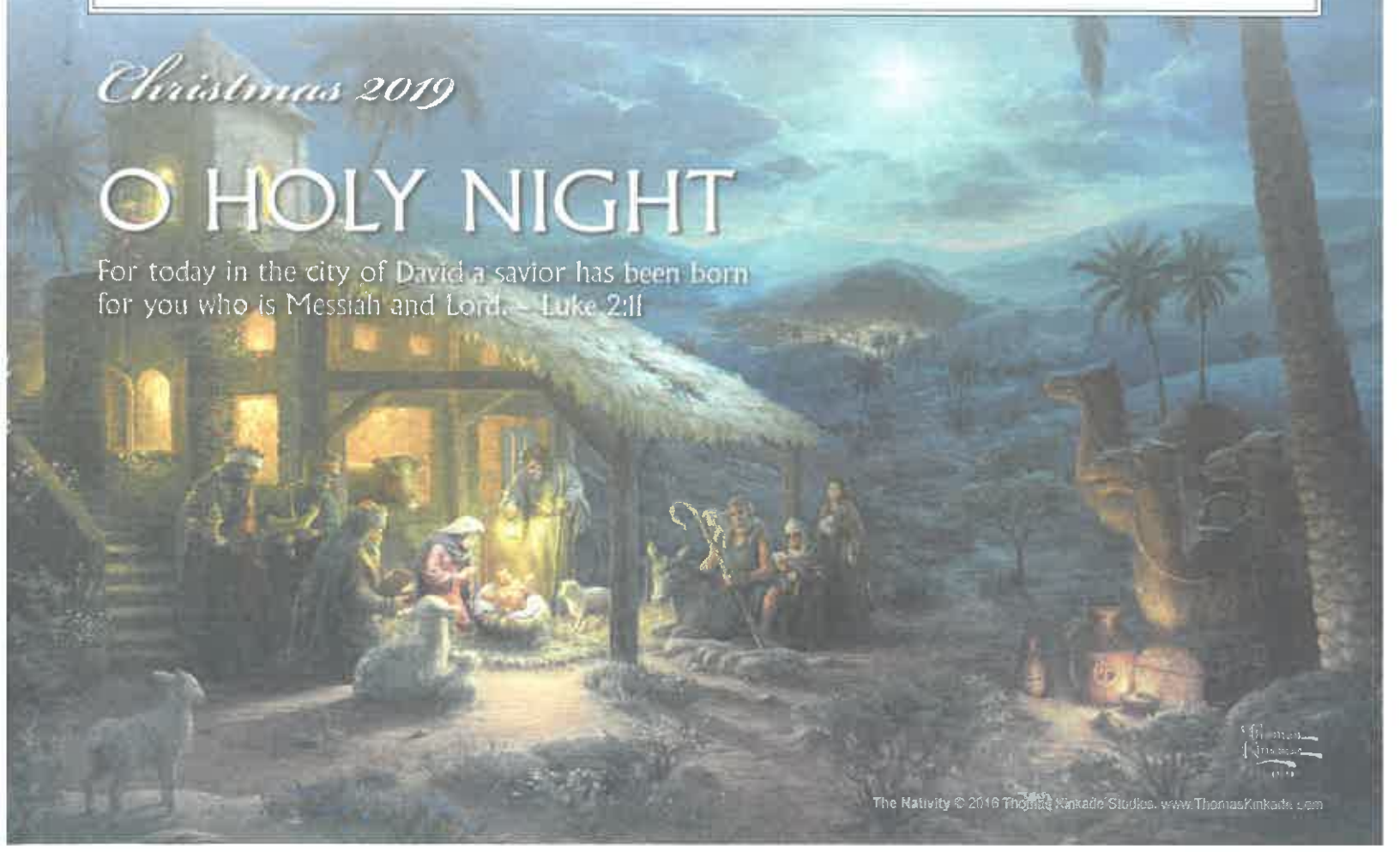

Merry Christmas - On behalf of the entire school, we wish you all a very blessed and joyful Christmas season.

Archdiocesan Financial Aide - The Archdiocese of Cincinnati is now accepting applications for financial aid for the 2020-2021 school year through the Catholic Education Foundation. In order to apply, families must complete the FACTS Grant and Aid Application. (FACTS is the tuition collection program used at St. James already.) Applications must be received by **January 31, 2020**. Eligible families can be awarded up to \$1,200 per student to attend St. James next year. Funds will be distributed based on the assessed financial need of families and will be without distinguishing between families based on religion or parishioner status. In 2020, we celebrate the 175th Anniversary of the Cathedral of Saint Peter in Chains and in 2021, we celebrate the Bicentennial (200th) anniversary of the founding of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati.

Part of that request is to be able to verify that a person is an "active member" of St. James the Greater Parish. An "active member" of this parish is one who: **1.** Is properly registered and on the parish census.
2. Faithfully attends Mass on Sundays and Holy Days.

3. Participates in parish activities when possible. **4.** Uses the parish envelope system.

NOTE: An adult child living at home should register as themselves or please notify the Parish Office when they no longer live at home with the parents.

While assessments of an inquirer's status will be made individually, the above are the main factors that will be considered in making that determination.
