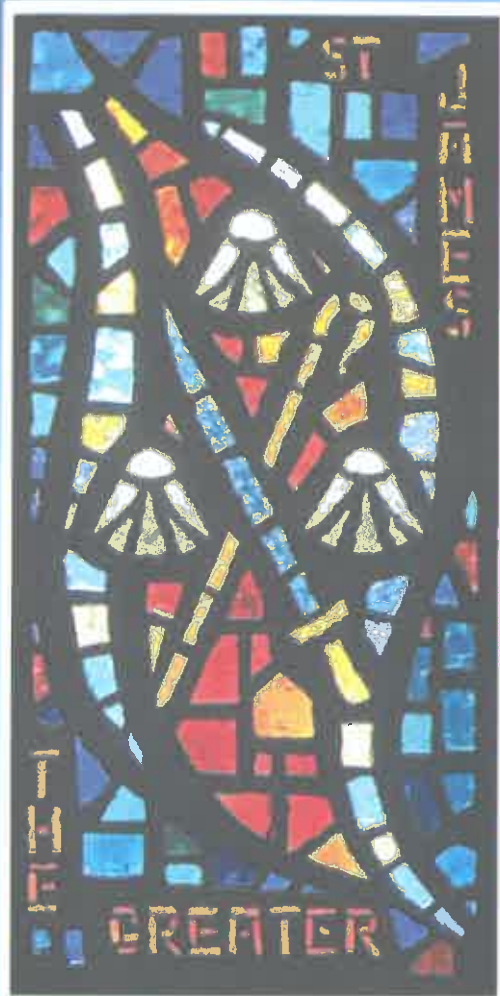

### Fasting and Abstinence

**Good Friday** is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat and meat products. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding from age 14 onwards.

### Food on Holy Thursday

At the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday (7:00 pm, April 1) **we will again be collecting non-perishable food items for the poor in addition to our monetary collection.** Everyone will be invited to come forward to present both the money and food which will go to a local pantry.



### Good Friday Collection

Pope Francis has asked our parish to support the Pontifical Good Friday Collection, which helps Christians in the Holy Land. Your support helps the church minister in parishes, provide Catholic schools and offer religious education., it also helps to preserve the sacred shrines.

The wars, unrest and instability have been especially hard on Christians. In these times of crisis, the Pontifical Good Friday Collection provides humanitarian aid to refugees.

When you contribute, you become an instrument of peace and join with Catholics around the world in solidarity with the Church in the Holy Land. PLEASE BE GENEROUS!

### Easter Sunday

**On Easter Sunday, we will have our regular schedule of Masses at 8:00 and 10:00 a.m.** As with Christmas, we cannot accommodate the crowds at these Masses that we have had in the past. We are still very observant of the requirements of masking and social distance. This gives us an approximate capacity of 250 people. **The 10:00 a.m. Mass will be livestream, as it is on all Sundays.** We encourage everyone to consider this alternative to in-person attendance.

**In the event we have an overflow crowd for the church for the 10:00 a.m. Mass, we will provide live-streaming in the church hall. This will include the distribution of Holy Communion.**

We also encourage everyone to consider joining us for the 9:00 p.m. Easter Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday. This is the most important liturgy of the year. Maybe this is the year to participate in-person as we begin our celebration of Easter.



### Preparing for Divine Mercy Sunday—April 11 The Divine Mercy Novena Begins on Good Friday, April 2

Jesus commanded St. Faustina to prepare for the Feast of The Divine Mercy with a special Novena. "On each day you will bring to My heart a different group of souls" and they may draw "whatever grace they need in the hardships of life and especially at the hour of death" (*Diary*, 1209). "Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity" (*Diary*, 699). The intercessory Chaplet of Divine

Mercy prayers can be added when praying this Novena. The words of the Chaplet were dictated by the Lord Jesus Himself (*Diary*, 475-476). The Lord promised "The souls that say this chaplet will be embraced by My mercy during their lifetime and especially at their death" (*Diary*, 754). When they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as the just Judge but as the Merciful Savior" (*Diary*, 1541). "Through the chaplet you will obtain everything, if what you ask for is compatible with My will" (*Diary*, 1731). Jesus Christ has also promised "complete forgiveness of sins and punishment" through the reception of Holy Communion *in a state of grace* on Divine Mercy Sunday (*Diary*, 699).
