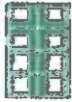

Religious Education Office

Children’s Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) will **NOT** be held during the rest of the 2020 calendar year. The Office of Religious Education will reevaluate towards the end of the year if we can have it resume during 2021.

NOTE CHANGE in Monday evening Parish School of Religion. (PSR)

PSR from Home: After much prayer and conversation, the Office of Religious Education will provide materials for students to do using CatechismClass.com resources. The lessons are weekly, with flexible scheduling for learning. Each family will be partnered with a catechist that they can check in with bi-weekly or monthly. During these meetings, parents and students will meet with the catechist, discuss questions, progress in the program, and any concerns that St. James can assist the family with. We hope to also hold monthly in-person activities/lessons for the PSR students and their families. You can visit CatechismClass.com or contact Claire Zink in the Parish Office for more information.

Sacrament Preparation for PSR: Sacrament Preparation will mostly be done at home. If your child will be in **2nd grade** for the 2020-2021 school year, you will receive the CatechismClass online program for your child’s sacrament prep.

If your child will be in the 7th grade for the 2020-2021 school year, they will do an at-home, online version of the confirmation prep course *Chosen*.

We hope to provide small group opportunities both in person and virtual.

Registration will close end of August.

Letters were sent to families with the registration forms. If you did not receive one and are interested in registering your child, please contact the Office of Religious Education at 513-741-5339.

Registration is OPEN!

To register for Sunday Preschool, fill out the registration form (found on our website under Home/Learn Tab) and send form and payment of \$35.00. The Last Day to Register is Aug. 27th. First day is Sept. 13th. Sunday Preschool is for children between the ages of 3-5 years. Refunds will be available at a prorated basis.
