Open Volunteer Position Descriptions

COMMITTEE POSITIONS: These are **vital** to the continuation of the festival in its present form.

- Grounds Committee Chair (2)
 - Attend monthly committee meetings, oversee and manage grounds from set up to tear down.
- Treasurer (1)
 - Attend Committee meetings, manage budget, work with Parish Business Manager to manage payments, prepare and coordinate distribution of festival dollars, prepare/assist cash room coordinator
- Children's Committee Members (2)
 - Attend monthly committee meetings, oversee/manage Children's booths

PRE-FESTIVAL/FESTIVAL POSITIONS: Require less time than committee positions
but time prior to or during festival weekend

- Sign-up Weekends Coordinator (1)
 - Confirm 1-2 people present at volunteer sign-up table each sign-up weekend, enter volunteers who aren't able to sign-up online, communicate rules and SafeParish requirements
- Set-up Coordinator (1)
 - Lead set-up volunteer, work with Grounds Committee Chairs to complete set-up tasks, coordinates set-up volunteers, facilitate finding additional volunteers if needed
- Sponsorship Committee Assistant (1)
 - Assist Sponsorship Chairs in finding sponsors and communications regarding sponsorships, develop relationships with past sponsors
- Morning Grounds Monitor (1-2)
 - Relieve overnight security, facilitate any pick-up or deliveries that may occur, and be present on the festival grounds from 7-11 AM Friday-Sunday
- Mid-day Grounds Monitor (1-2)
 - Relieve morning Grounds Monitor in facilitation of pick-up or deliveries from 11 AM - 3 PM Saturday and Sunday
- Maintenance Coordinator (1)
 - Lead maintenance volunteer, present nightly or provides a suitable alternative to stand in as lead volunteer – a lead volunteer needs to be present at every shift each night, coordinate parking lot attendants and first-aid volunteers, facilitate finding additional volunteers if needed, attend to any bathroom mishaps
- Bid-N-Buy Coordinator (1)
 - Coordinate Bid-N-Buy process, set-up, merchandise, and volunteers
- Clean-up Coordinator (1)
 - Lead clean-up volunteer, work with Grounds Committee Chairs to complete clean-up tasks, coordinate clean-up volunteers, facilitate finding additional volunteers if needed
- Parking Coordinator (1)
 - Facilitate the parking lot attendants by recruiting and explaining the organization of parking in both the church and field lots to volunteers, assuring that they have needed supplies, communicate with officers on duty concerning any issues that may arise.

Positions that require multiple volunteers

- General Pre-festival "On Call" Volunteers (5+)
 - "On Call" to help as needed whenever available
- Set-up Volunteers (10+)
 - Assist in setting up the Festival grounds
- Parking Lot Attendants (6+)
 - Facilitate parking lot

 - Assist in cleaning up the festival grounds nightly and the Monday following the festival
