The John Merritt High School Scholarships

Each year two (2) \$2000 scholarships are awarded to graduating students from St. James to be applied to that student's tuition at a Catholic high school. This grant is renewable for each year of high school as long as the student meets the necessary requirements.

The criteria are:

- 1) The student is a baptized practicing Catholic, whose participation in Sunday Mass is verifiable and known to the pastor;
- 2) The student's family offers gifts of time, talent and treasure to the parish;
- 3) There is demonstrated financial need¹;
- 4) Academic achievement is commensurate with ability;
- 5) The student is involved in at least one aspect of parish or school community life;
- 6) The student's family has applied for this scholarship.
- 7) The student has submitted an essay explaining why Catholic education is important to him/her.

For the scholarship to be renewed for the next three years, the student must

- 1) Be in good standing at the school;
- 2) Be involved in one extracurricular activity at the school;
- 3) maintain academic excellence commensurate with ability;
- 4) Continue to be involved in the sacramental life (Sunday Mass) at St. James in a verifiable manner

The scholarships are decided by the Pastor, the Principal of St. James School and the Parish Business Manager in the spring of each year.

Applications for the high school scholarships must be received by March 1, 2020.

¹ Financial need will be determined using the information submitted for tuition assistance for St. James School for the student's 8th grade year. If tuition assistance was not requested for St. James School, parents should submit the same information as was given to the high schools for their tuition assistance programs.

Each year two (2) \$750 scholarships are given to students currently attending or intending to attend St. James School. This is a one-time grant which is not automatically renewable. Students could be eligible for more than one year.

The criteria are:

- 1) The student is a baptized practicing Catholic, whose participation in Sunday Mass is verifiable and known to the pastor;
- 2) The student's family offers gifts of time, talent and treasure to the parish;
- 3) There is demonstrated financial need shown through the regular information submitted to the parish for financial assistance;
- 4) Academic achievement is commensurate with ability;
- 5) The student is involved in at least one aspect of parish or school community life;

The scholarships are decided by the Pastor, the Principal of Saint James School and the Parish Business Manager in the spring of each year.

Applications for students attending St. James School must be received by March 1, 2020.
