St. James School Update

The Week Ahead **Catholic Schools Week**

The students are diving into Catholic Schools Week activities tomorrow! We are all so grateful and blessed to be a part of such a wonderful Catholic School. The PTO will have a board meeting on **Wednesday evening at 7:00 pm.**

Archdiocesan Financial Aide - The Archdiocese of Cincinnati is now accepting applications for financial aid for the 2021-2022 school year through the Catholic Education Foundation. In order to apply, families must complete the FACTS Grant and Aid Application. (FACTS is the tuition collection program used at St. James already.) **Applications must be received by January 31, 2021.** Eligible families can be awarded up to \$1,200 per student to attend St. James School next year. Funds will be distributed based on the assessed financial need of families and will be without distinguishing between families based on religion or parishioner status. Registration—St. James School is now accepting registrations for the 2021-2022 school year. New students can register online by visiting our website at www.stjameswo.org. Click on the Prospective Families tab to find directions on how to register online. If you have questions about enrollment or would like to schedule a school tour, please contact us at 741-5333 or by email at jfulmer@stjameswo.org.



The John Merritt Scholarships—Each year, two (2) \$2,000 scholarships are awarded by our parish to graduating students from St. James to

be applied to that student’s tuition at a Catholic high school. This grant is renewable for each year of high school as long as the student meets the necessary requirements.

Each year, two (2) \$750 scholarships are given to students currently attending or intending to attend St. James School. This is a one-time grant which is not automatically renewable. Students could be eligible for more than one year.

Full information about these scholarships has been sent home with students in our school. It is also available on the parish and school websites. Application deadline is March 1, 2021.



Martyrs give the supreme witness to truth of the faith. This week, we celebrate three martyrs, St. Blaise (4th century) on Wednesday, St. Agatha (3rd century) on Friday, and St. Paul Miki and Companions (17th century) on Saturday. We are excited to bring our Fish Fry Back! There will be significant changes with losing our dine-in option for this year! But we are ready to provide delicious carry-out meals to you and your families! Our hours will be shortened slightly this year: 4:30 - 7:00 p.m. We will still need MANY volunteers as food runners. Please consider volunteering if you are able to! You will need to wear a mask and can comment if you need different hours than listed on the sign-up sheet. Our Fish Fry will be Carry-Out ONLY. There will be 3 options to order:

1. Come in as usual, with a mask, and place a carry-out order to take with you.
2. Download the app "MyMenuHelper" to your smart phone. Find our St. James Fish Fry. Place order, select pick-up time and pay through the app. We have curbside, contact-less pick-up in our church lot.
3. Call the church hall at 741-5311 between the hours of 2:00 p.m.- 6:45 p.m. to place order and choose pick-up time for curbside pick-up. Pay at pick-up. We accept cash, checks or credit cards. This is a single phone line, so please be patient.

We are serving delicious Fried Fish, Baked Fish or Fried Shrimp Dinners each with 2 sides; your choice of coleslaw, green beans or applesauce and choice of French fries or mac and cheese. Fish Dinners come with North College Hill Bakery Bread in your choice of White, Rye, or Salted Rye. We also have Fried Fish Baskets, large and small, with Fries and Coleslaw. Also, LaRosa's will be onsite with the Pizza Truck for hot, delicious LaRosa's Pizzas to add to your order!
