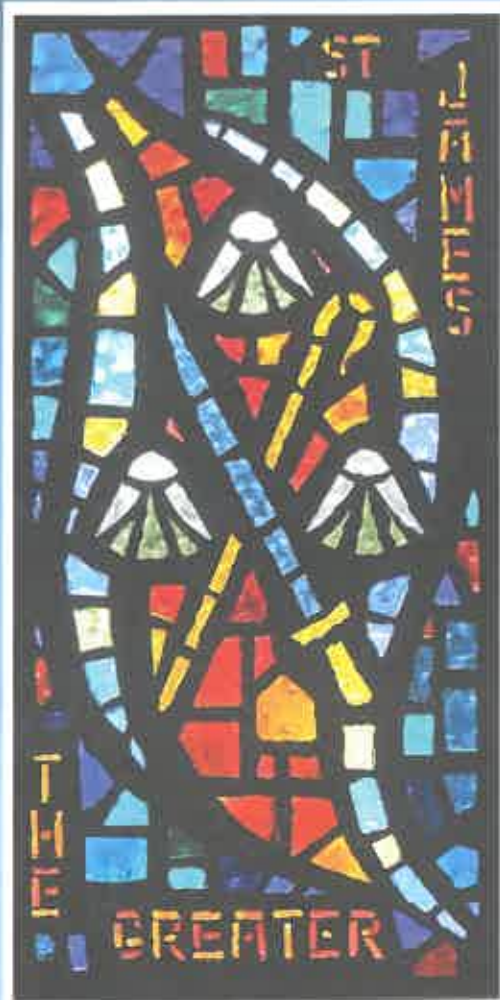

The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Council Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

NEW PARISHIONERS – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS OR PARISHIONER STATUS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

Taking Communion to Someone Not Able to Be with Us at Mass

In order to safeguard the respect for Our Lord Jesus Christ who is truly present in the Eucharist, we ask that if you are taking Holy Communion to someone at home or visiting someone after Mass that you follow these simple guidelines: use only a pyx to carry the host. Pyxes are available to borrow in the Hubble Road Sacristy. It is preferred that you do not come up in line at Communion time and request host(s) to be distributed later, rather, proceed to the Blessed Sacrament Chapel immediately after Mass and a Coordinator will be there to assist in retrieving host(s) from the tabernacle. This way you can go directly to visit the person/people without having Our Lord in a purse or pocket. We earnestly desire to assist you in your ministry of taking Holy Communion to those unable to be with us at Mass, *and* to ensure the ultimate in respect to Our Lord in the Eucharist. Thank you for understanding.

All families, friends and parishioners are invited to come to remember the memory of your loved one, along with all the faithful departed of St. James Parish and to celebrate the gift of eternal life.

Book of Remembrance

Since the 16. century, the Church has dedicated the month of November to the Holy Souls. Prayer for the dead is one of the greatest acts of charity we can perform. Our prayers help them during their time in Purgatory, so that they can enter more quickly into the fullness of Heaven. **During November**, this special month of prayer, our **Book of Remembrance** will be available in the West Vestibule for you to enter the names of your deceased family members and friends.

This book is not to be confused with the one in the Baptistery in which we have inscribed the names of everyone who was buried from St. James during the past twelve months. The Holy Souls listed in both books will be remembered at all our Masses during November.

Tuition Assistance Donations

We are pleased to announce that the ESAP Program through the George Hubert Foundation is going to match any donations we receive at St. James up to \$12,000 at a rate of 150%! **Therefore, if we receive \$12,000 in tuition assistance donations by December 1st, ESAP match will be \$18,000.** This will give us \$30,000 in tuition assistance plus the ESAP donation of \$6,000 that is designated to our parish school for a total of \$36,000. 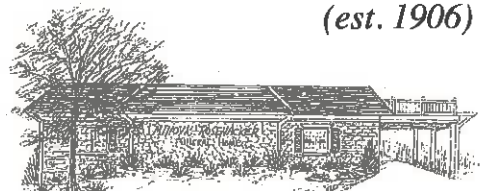
