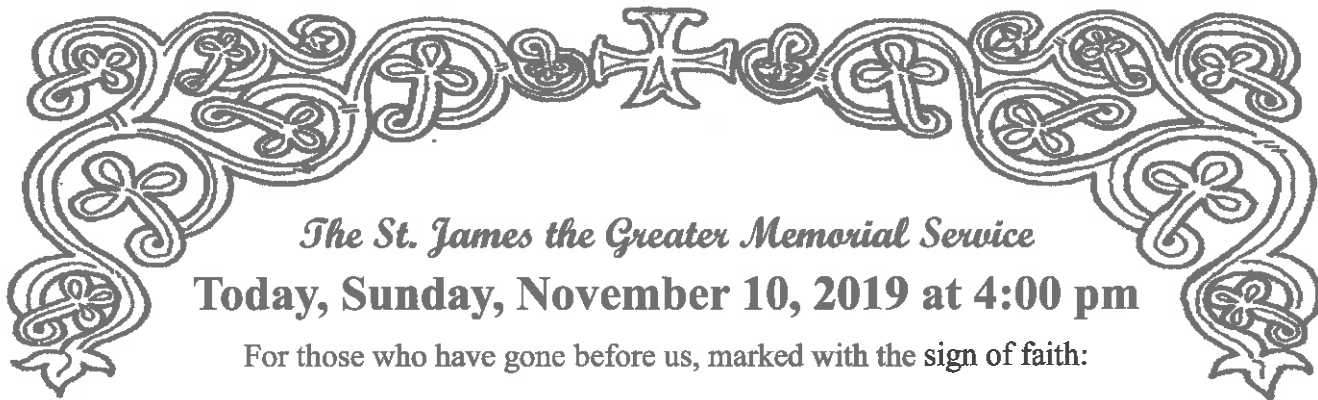
Book of Remembrance

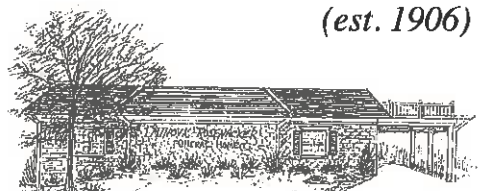
