Book of Remembrance

Since the 16th century, the Church has dedicated the month of November to the Holy Souls. Prayer for the dead is one of the greatest acts of charity we can perform. Our prayers help them during their time in Purgatory, so that they can enter more quickly into the fullness of Heaven. **During November**, this special month of prayer, our **Book of Remembrance** will be available in the West Vestibule for you to enter the names of your deceased family members and friends.

This book is not to be confused with the one in the Baptistry, in which we have inscribed the names of everyone who was buried from St. James during the past twelve months. The Holy Souls listed in both books will be remembered at all our Masses during November.

Penance Service for Advent & First Reconciliation for our Catholic 2nd Graders

Our service will be on **Monday, December 2nd at 7 pm**. Several priests will be available for Confession. At this service, our Catholic 2nd graders will receive the sacrament for the first time. Join them and all the other parishioners to celebrate God's mercy and to prepare to celebrate Christmas.

Feast of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, December 9th

This year, **December 8th is the Second Sunday of Advent**, which is more important in the Church's calendar. The Feast of the Immaculate Conception moves to Monday, December 9th — and is **NOT** a holy day and there is no obligation to participate in Mass. The only Mass will be the normal 8:30 am.

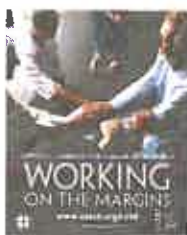

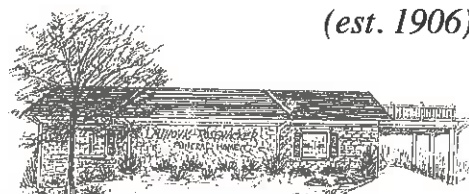
