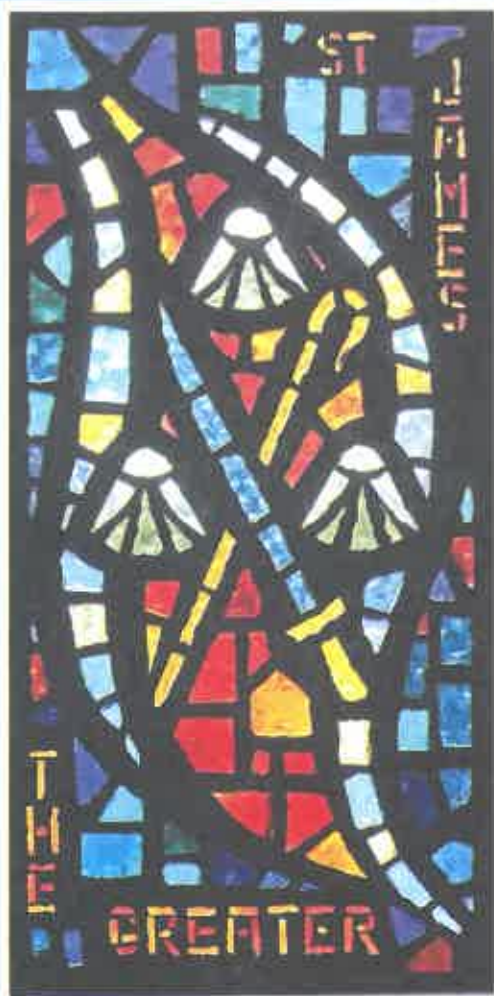
INFANT BAPTISMS – The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated the 4th Sunday of each month at 11:30 a.m. Parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Program, preferably 2 months prior to the birth of the child. The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Council Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

NEW PARISHIONERS – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS OR PARISHIONER STATUS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

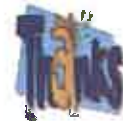

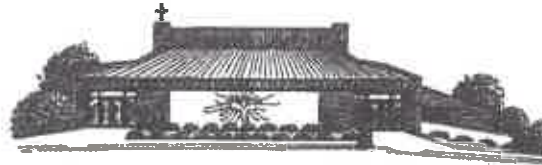

Calling on all Saint James Parishioners!

In 2020 we celebrate the 175th Anniversary of the Cathedral of Saint Peter in Chains and in 2021 we celebrate the Bicentennial (200th) anniversary of the founding of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati.

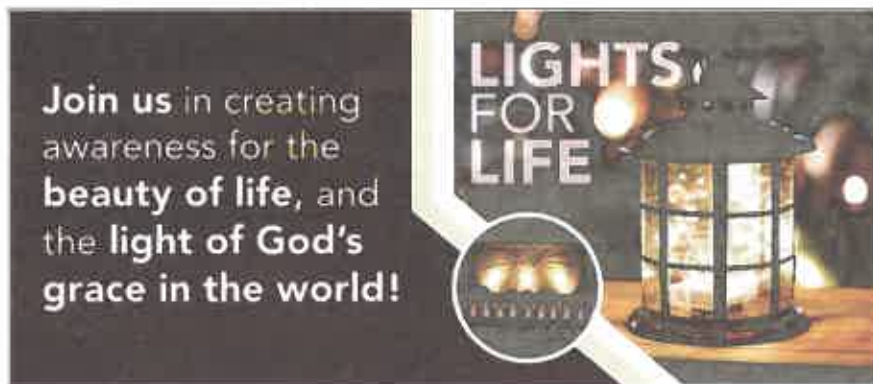
Saint James L.I.F.E. Ministry Advent Calendar Sale will be after all Masses in the Church Hall on this weekend .

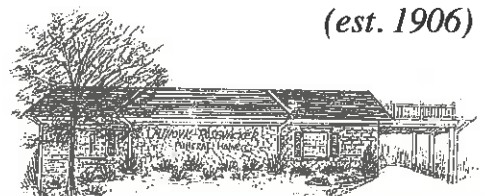
