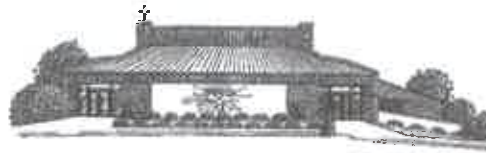

### Calling on all Saint James Parishioners!

In 2020, we celebrate the 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Cathedral of Saint Peter in Chains and in 2021 we celebrate the Bicentennial (200<sup>th</sup>) anniversary of the founding of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati.

For more than 30 years, there has been a tradition at the Cathedral of displaying a very large Christmas Tree decorated with ornaments submitted by each parish.

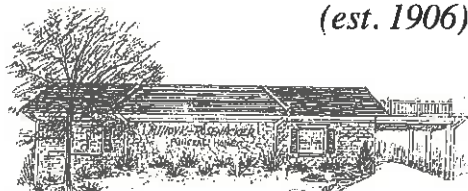
