**The John Merritt Scholarships**—Each year two (2) \$2000 scholarships are awarded by our parish to graduating students from St. James to be applied to that student’s tuition at a Catholic high school. This grant is renewable for each year of high school as long as the student meets the necessary requirements.

Each year two (2) \$750 scholarships are given to students currently attending or intending to attend St. James School. This is a one-time grant which is not automatically renewable. Students could be eligible for more than one year.

Full information about these scholarships has been sent home with students in our school. It is also

available on the parish and school websites. **Application deadline is March 1, 2021.**

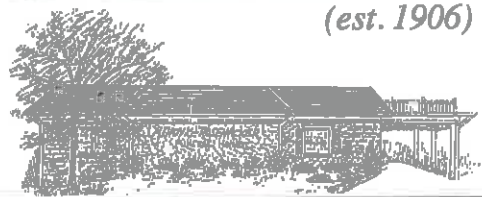
