## In the Year of St. Joseph

As was mentioned in *Parish Life*, Pope Francis has designated 2021 as a special time in honor of St. Joseph. It was 150 years ago that St. Joseph was declared the patron saint of the whole Catholic Church by Blessed Pope Pius IX. The Holy Father has asked all of us to celebrate our devotion to St. Joseph in special ways during this year. The Church is even offering a special plenary indulgence for those who participate in honoring St. Joseph. (See below.) As a parish, we will call on St. Joseph's help in two special ways.

### The Novena

We will observe a special Novena in honor of St. Joseph, using the prayer Pope Francis uses to conclude his Apostolic Letter on St. Joseph. We will recite this together at each Mass

between March 10 and the great feast of St. Joseph on March 19. If you cannot pray with us at Mass each day, the prayer is printed here for inclusion in your private prayers each day.

### Mass on March 19

Mass will include the celebration of Morning Prayer from the Liturgy of the Hours, the Church's official prayer to sanctify each day. In Lent we include Morning Prayer in Mass on Fridays, and since the great feast falls on a Friday, we will include it with great solemnity as we honor St. Joseph. The Novena Prayer will be prayed along with the Litany of St. Joseph. Doing this we will meet the prayer requirements for the special plenary indulgence.

### The Plenary Indulgence

To celebrate this special year, the Holy Father has approved a plenary indulgence to Catholics who choose to take part in the special year in one of six outlined ways. Although such Catholics are obliged, as usual, to also make a confession, receive the Eucharist, and pray for the pope's intentions, the decree recognizes that some will be unable to do so in line with pandemic social distancing measures. "In the current context of the health emergency, the gift of the plenary indulgence is particularly extended to the elderly, the sick, those close to death and all those who for legitimate reasons find it impossible to leave their homes," the decree states, suggesting such persons can obtain the indulgence by having an intention to fulfill the requirements "as soon as it's possible."

### The six ways Catholics can celebrate the year include:

- Meditating for at least 30 minutes on the Our Father;
- Undertaking a work of spiritual or corporal mercy in the example of St. Joseph, who is called a "just man" in Matthew's Gospel;
- Reciting the Holy Rosary among your family or with your partner;
- Entrusting your daily work to the protection of St. Joseph, or invoking the intercession of St. Joseph in trying to find employment;
- Reciting the Litany of St. Joseph, or making another similar prayer, on behalf of persecuted Christians; and,
- Making an act of piety in honor of St. Joseph on the 19th of the month or on Wednesday, the day traditionally dedicated to the saint's memory.

### Novena Prayer

From Pope Francis

*Hail, Guardian of the Redeemer,  
Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary.  
To you God entrusted His only Son;  
in you Mary placed her trust;  
with you Christ became man.*

*Blessed Joseph, to us too,  
show yourself a father  
and guide us in the path of life.  
Obtain for us grace, mercy and courage,  
and defend us from every evil. Amen.*

### **Abstinence on March 19**

Friday, March 19 is the Solemn Feast of St. Joseph. The Church's law says in Canon 1251 that we do not do any penance on solemn feasts. That means there is no obligation to observe the usual Lenten abstinence on March 19. The Archbishop has suggested that, especially during this Year of St. Joseph, it would be appropriate for the faithful to celebrate a special dinner in their household and, if possible, to contribute food to the poor. Bon Appetit with St. Joseph!

### **Covid-19 Vaccines**

There continues to be confusion about the morality of receiving the Covid-19 vaccines, especially the one produced by Johnson & Johnson. As recently as last week, The United States Conference of Bishops (USCCB) issued a statement. Speaking on behalf of the entire Conference of Bishops, Bishop Kevin Rhodes of Ft. Wayne-South Bend, Indiana said: "There's no moral need to turn down a vaccine, including the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, which is morally acceptable to use." The bishop cited an earlier Vatican statement that "has made clear that all the COVID vaccines recognized as clinically safe and effective can be used in good conscience." "What's most important is that people get vaccinated," Rhoades continued. "It can be an act of charity that serves the common good."

This follows the very clear teaching from the Vatican's Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith issued on December 21, 2020. Due to the situation of the ongoing pandemic, "all vaccinations recognized as clinically safe and effective can be used in good conscience with the certain knowledge that the use of such vaccines does not constitute formal cooperation with the abortion from which the cells used in production of the vaccines derive."

Some Catholic media sources do not agree with the Vatican and the USCCB statements and continue to publish inaccurate statements. Dismiss them. Only pay attention to the Vatican and USCCB.

### **Easter Sunday**

On Easter Sunday, we will have our regular schedule of Masses at 8:00 and 10:00 a.m. As with Christmas, we cannot accommodate the crowds at these Masses that we have had in the past. We are still very observant of the requirements of masking and social distance. This gives us an approximate capacity of 250 people. The 10:00 a.m. Mass will be livestream, as it is on all Sundays. We encourage everyone to consider this alternative to in-person attendance.

In the event we have an overflow crowd for the church for the 10:00 a.m. Mass, we will provide live-streaming in the church hall. This will include the distribution of Holy Communion.

We also encourage everyone to consider joining us for the 9:00 p.m. Easter Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday. This is the most important liturgy of the year. Maybe this is the year to participate in-person as we begin our celebration of Easter.

## Image of The Divine Mercy and Its Promises

Jesus wants every soul to know about this Image, which is to remind us “to trust in Him and be merciful to others” (*Diary*, 342). Our Lord attached special promises to venerating the Image of The Divine Mercy, promises such as eternal salvation, the grace of a happy death, and of all other possible graces which people will ask of Him with trust (*Diary*, 48). The Image speaks to the heart on a level deeper than mere words. As [St.] Pope John Paul II once said, “Anyone can look at this Image of the Merciful Jesus and hear in the depths of his own soul what [St.] Faustina heard: ‘Fear nothing; I am always with you’ (*Diary*, 586). And if this person responds with a sincere heart, ‘Jesus, I trust in You,’ he will find comfort in all his anxieties and fears.” Attend Holy Mass on Divine Mercy Sunday in a state of grace and receive Holy Communion with great trust in His Mercy and obtain “complete forgiveness of sins and punishment” (*Diary*, 699).
