In the Year of St. Joseph

As was mentioned in *Parish Life*, Pope Francis has designated 2021 as a special time in honor of St. Joseph. It was 150 years ago that St. Joseph was declared the patron saint of the whole Catholic Church by Blessed Pope Pius IX. The Holy Father has asked all of us to celebrate our devotion to St. Joseph in special ways during this year. The Church is even offering a special plenary indulgence for those who participate in honoring St. Joseph. (See below.) As a parish, we will call on St. Joseph's help in two special ways.

The Novena

We will observe a special novena in honor of St. Joseph, using the prayer Pope Francis uses to conclude his Apostolic Letter on St. Joseph. We will recite

this together at each Mass between March 10 and the great feast of St. Joseph on March 19. If you cannot pray with us at Mass each day, the prayer is printed here for inclusion in your private prayers each day.

Mass on March 19

Mass will include the celebration of Morning Prayer from the Liturgy of the Hours, the Church's official prayer to sanctify each day. In Lent we include Morning Prayer in Mass on Fridays, and since the great feast falls on a Friday, we will include it with great solemnity as we honor St. Joseph. The Novena Prayer will be prayed along with the Litany of St. Joseph. Doing this we will meet the prayer requirements for the special plenary Indulgence.

The Plenary Indulgence

To celebrate this special year, the Holy Father has approved a plenary indulgence to Catholics who choose to take part in the special year in one of six outlined ways. Although such Catholics are obliged, as usual, to also make a confession, receive the Eucharist, and pray for the pope's intentions, the decree recognizes that some will be unable to do so in line with pandemic social distancing measures. "In the current context of the health emergency, the gift of the plenary indulgence is particularly extended to the elderly, the sick, those close to death and all those who for legitimate reasons find it impossible to leave their homes," the decree states, suggesting such persons can obtain the indulgence by having an intention to fulfill the requirements "as soon as it's possible."

The six ways Catholics can celebrate the year include:

- Meditating for at least 30 minutes on the Our Father;
- Undertaking a work of spiritual or corporal mercy in the example of Joseph, who is called a "just man" in Matthew's Gospel;
- Reciting the holy rosary among your family or with your partner;
- Entrusting your daily work to the protection of Joseph, or invoking the intercession of Joseph in trying to find employment;
- Reciting the Litany of St. Joseph, or making another similar prayer, on behalf of persecuted Christians; and,
- Making an act of piety in honor of Joseph on the 19th of the month or on Wednesday, the day traditionally dedicated to the saint's memory.

Novena Prayer

From Pope Francis

*Hail, Guardian of the Redeemer,
Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
To you God entrusted His only Son;
in you Mary placed her trust;
with you Christ became man.*

*Blessed Joseph, to us too,
show yourself a father
and guide us in the path of life.
Obtain for us grace, mercy and courage,
and defend us from every evil. Amen.*

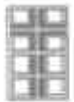


Trust in The Divine Mercy—The Last Hope of Salvation

Trust—and nothing more—is what the Lord asks us to bring to Divine Mercy Sunday in order “to receive the whole ocean of His mercy” (*Diary*, 1520, 1578). “The graces of My Mercy are drawn by means of one vessel only, and that is—trust. The more a soul trusts, the more it will receive” (*Diary*, 1578). Even sinners who convert on the Day of the Feast are called to participate in all the graces, in all their extent that Jesus prepared for this Feast. Christ promised an exceptional abundance of graces—a complete renewal of Baptism—to those who receive Holy

Communion *in a state of grace* with great trust in His Mercy on Divine Mercy Sunday. This Feast is a time of grace for all people (*Diary*, 699). “Souls perish in spite of My bitter Passion. I am giving them the last hope of salvation, that is, recourse to My Mercy. If they will not adore My mercy, they will perish for all eternity” (*Diary*, 965, 998). So Our Lord’s promise of complete forgiveness is both a reminder and a call. He is waiting for us to turn to Him with trust. And it is a call for all to be washed clean in His Love through the mercy miracles of Confession and Holy Communion—no matter how terrible our sins—and begin our lives again. He is offering us a new start!

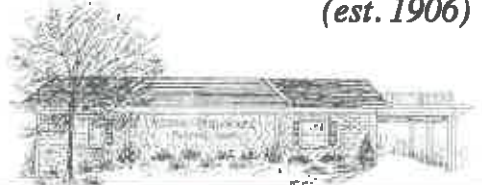
