In the everyday language the word "exposed" is often connected with taking a risk. We can be exposed to many bad influences or events in our everyday lives.

When the Blessed Sacrament is exposed on the altar, Jesus is also actually taking a risk. The risk is our rejection of His love by depriving Him of our visits. He is present and waiting on the altar during Eucharist Exposition. Please consider stopping in for a visit, even if it is for just to say "Hello" and thank Him for your blessings.

## Learn Together

### Fasting and Abstinence



Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat and meat products.

Good Friday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding from age 14 onwards.

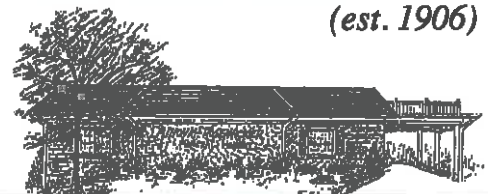
