SAFE PARISH

The new Child Protection Platform for the AoC.

All new volunteers and employees should follow the SafeParish registration instructions for creating a SafeParish account. During the registration process, new volunteers and employees will be invited to complete their online background check and their child protection training online. New employees will also need to complete manual fingerprinting and submit a B4 form for approval.

Weekly Emails: Each Tuesday, SafeParish sends an email regarding the updated child protection and workplace safety articles that are posted on the SafeParish website. These articles are NOT required but are recommended reading.

Quarterly Bulletins: The 1st Quarter bulletin was published Friday, March 25th, and needs to be completed by April 24th. **PRECIOUS BLOOD**

Effective April 24, 2022 (the Octave Day of Easter), the Archdiocese has given permission to return to the distribution of the Precious Blood at Mass. The Church teaches that "By reason of sign value, sharing in both Eucharistic species reflects more fully the sacred realities that the Liturgy signifies." (*Norms for the Distribution and Reception of Holy Communion under Both Kinds*). "Holy Communion has a fuller form as a sign when it takes place under both kinds." (General Instruction of the Roman Missal). Therefore, the Precious Blood will be offered at all Masses beginning that weekend. Receiving Holy Communion from the cup remains optional.

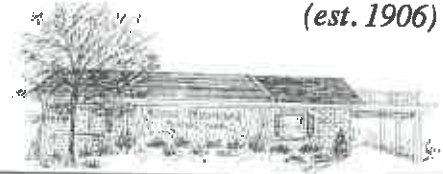

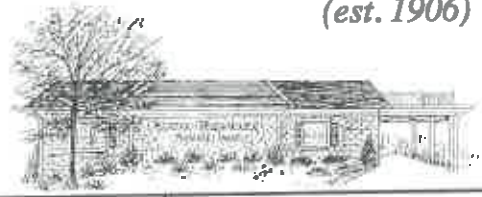
