THE PILGRIMAGE

The pilgrimage begins Sunday, May 16, 2021 with a Mass at the Our Lady of Fatima Shrine in Russells Point in the Northern area of the Archdiocese.

From there, small groups of pilgrims will begin this historic pilgrimage with a special statue of Our Lady of Fatima, blessed by Archbishop Schnurr for this occasion.

The pilgrimage will last for 33 days, making stops at parishes in every deanery of the Archdiocese, and will be highlighted by four cornerstone family events.

The pilgrimage will end at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Peter in Chains on the day of the bicentennial, Saturday, June 19, 2021. On that day, the Archbishop will re-consecrate the Archdiocese to Jesus through Mary during a special Mass commemorating the bicentennial.

Child Protection Policy—Protecting God's Children:

REMEMBER—To keep up on reading your monthly bulletins, after you have already taken the workshop. You will receive your 1st bulletin immediately after taking the workshop.

New volunteers must attend a VIRTUS workshop and complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account prior to volunteering or coaching before July 1st. For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. EVERYONE NEEDS to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). This is a one-time requirement.

Upcoming workshops: <u>Preregistration ONLINE</u> is required before attending a workshop. You will be required to read monthly bulletins to remain approved to volunteer. See our web page for other locations and dates.

*<u>UPDATE</u> from the Archdiocese: New Platform for Child Protection Training and Compliance Coming!

TO ALL PARISH VOLUNTEERS: NEW CHILD PROTECTION PLATFORM -

In July 2021 the Archdiocese will be moving to SafeParish as the new platform for Child Protection training and compliance. SafeParish is an organization that specializes in training and education solutions for organizations world-wide. They have 20+ years of experience in providing child safe environment training programs. SafeParish will continue to work with our current background check provider — Selection.com. All training and background information in your current VIRTUS account will be transferred to SafeParish. No new live training through SafeParish will be required if you have completed live child protection training through VIRTUS. Ongoing child protection training will still be required for all volunteers and employees and will consist of quarterly interactive video-based training instead of monthly bulletins. As the Archdiocese moves closer to the conversion date, additional information regarding your new SafeParish account will be provided. If you have questions, please contact your parish's Safe Environment Coordinator.
